

Peacemakers

Mt 5:9 — No one who is not a peacemaker will be called a son of God. Everyone who shall be called a son of God must be a peacemaker. And you, my son, shall bear the name of peacemaker. Ask and it shall be given you to be called (peacemaker). Oseh Shalom. Being a peacemaker does not mean a man of peace only, or being able to hold peace when you would rather speak, but a peacemaker means one who works earnestly to make peace between every human relationship. Everyone who has received the glory of Yahshua which the father gave him will be a worker peaceful relations between brothers and sisters in the body of Messiah. Jn 17:22 — The work is in cooperation with the Spirit who unites all our hearts as one and manifests that oneness until we all are perfectly united in love (Eph 4:1-3,4-7,11-16) as verse 13, until we all attain to the unity of the faith ... in the bond of peace (verse 3). All who are being diligent to preserve the unity of the spirit are peacemakers. But one must be diligent. No one will be called a son of God without diligence to make peace (Mt 5:9).

The calling with which you are now called must be worked out with all humility — gentleness, patience — showing forbearance to one another because you love one another (1 Jn 3:14-24) and “have love” for one another (Jn 13:34-35). You must (have love) and give to be a *peacemaker*, you must have love for your brothers. And having love for them, give it to them in the situation that requires a peacemaker’s ministry and grace.

You must make peace — between every human relationship by prayer and action. So you bear the name everyone should be who are going to be called the sons of God in Eternity. Wherever you go in the universe in the ministry to the nations you will be called “a son of YHWH,” as everyone who is a peacemaker now on earth in this age will be called. All must preserve the unity in the bond of peace today, in order to rule over the nations in the ages to come. Since you bear the name *Peacemaker* you will let everyone know what a peacemaker is — as Yahshua let everyone know what Yahweh’s salvation was.

Yahshua and the *Oseh Shalom’s* will work together to maintain the peace of the universe forever and ever without end. This is the work that we must be engaged in today if we are they who shall be called the sons of God then (Col 1:17).
