The Victory Cup

Rev 2:11; Lk 22:18 — The saintswho survive will drink this cup anew in that kingdom. If we do not suffer with Him we will not reign with Him. It's according to our suffering that we will experience the degree of glory we'll experience (Rev 3:20 21; 2 Tim 2:11 12; Jms 1:12; 1 Pet 4:13). Rom 8:17 — If we suffer so we can be glorified with Him. Col 1:23 — If we continue. Phil 1:29 — We must not only believe in Him but we must suffer with Him. We cannot let anything slide for then our sins begin to pile up. The light of our conscience shines on us. We must receive this light and not ignore and reject that light and sear our conscience because unconfessed sin cuts us off and extinguishes our light. We need to confess every sin we *did not judge* to our Father or our brothers.

Jn 11:25 26 — An atoning sacrifice is the only escape from dying for our own sins. Heb 9:27 — Every man not receiving the sacrifice of Messiah for their sins must pay for their own sin by *their own* death (Rom 6:23), but this does not necessarily mean that they will experience the second death (Rev 20:11 15, Rev 22:15) — only those who "love lying." All die and are judged. Some for their rejecting forgiveness that was offered through a sent one. Some for their pushing away the voice of their conscience. Is the deliberate sin against our conscience we keep doing, if we see it we must *judge* it. We must grow into the Marvelous light, that Peter speaks of (1 Pet 2:9) by walking in it each day. We are not a marvelous light yet but we will be someday. Rev 20:12,15 — All who didn't rise at the first judgment will rise and be judged at the second judgment. This last judgment is for all the nations. Ecc 12:14 — All the secret deeds will come out, then everything hidden will be judged. Rom 2:15 16 — The secrets of men will be exposed. Rom 20:12 — These are pointing to this Last judgment.

Rev 13:8 — By then everyone on the earth is either written in the Lamb's book of life from the foundation of the earth or they worship the beast. The survivors who go into the next age will enter into the New Covenant whether they're from the nations or physical Israel. They will receive the New Covenant in that age as we have in this age. Refinements. At this second judgment, all not in the Book of life were cast into the second death. If their name was found they will be in the nations. Acts 13:46 — Since they rejected the call to be a part of the Bride then they judged themselves unworthy of eternal life. Rev 17:8; Rev 13:8 qualifies this as the book of life of the Lamb and not the book of life of Rev 20:12. We believe the Holy Spirit has revealed that the survivors of the nations will be living alternatively, not involved with the world system and these survivors' *names* have been written from before the foundation of the world in the book of life of *the Lamb*. If we walk in the light (1 Jn 1:7), we enjoy our abundant *social life*. So during the millennium they will be in their mortal bodies and enter the New Covenant. However, there will be descendants of theirs who will not. They will either die at 100 or be deceived at Satan's release.

Phil 4:3 — Paul knew by the Holy Spirit that these fellow workers' names were in the book of life (of the Kingdom). If we continue in lawless deeds, we will be excluded from the king dom. Those who endure through the 45 days of judgment will not have their names erased from the book of life. At this judgment (2 Cor 5:10; Rev 3:5; 2:11), believers who don't overcome will be hurt by the second death. Rev 3:5 — Only a few were keeping themselves with unsoiled gar ments; the others all had uncompleted deeds which was a test imony against them. They will not be raised to enter into the resurrection of the just, but their names were written in the Lamb's book of Life (Rev 2:27).

The Lamb's book of life (Holy city) — brought about by his faithfulness. The book of life (Kingdom) — recorded for life in the kingdom. The book of life — whether you are to enter in the nations. When you are baptized (saved) you are recorded in two books:

- a. The Lamb's book for the Holy City, because of the Lamb's faithfulness.
- b. The Book of Life (Rev 3:5) for our faithfulness.

Rev 21:27 — This book of life of the Lamb it is not according to our works or own purity. But the book of life for believers is something we must prove worthy of (2 Ths 1:5). A better resurrection (Heb 11:35) — that somehow meant to attain to the Phil 3:11 resurrection. 2 Cor 5:10 — The judgment is based on works of faith (Jn 10:28).

Mt 18:34-35 — This is being hurt by the second death until we can come to pay our debt of gratitude. Mt 24:13 — Whoever endures to the end will be in the book of life.
