### Types of Government

A republic is a government with definite boundaries upon it to ensure that the government remains a servant of the people and not their master. George Washington refused to be king, but he did become a president, a servant-leader. Thomas Jefferson exhorted his country to bind down from mischief the government by the chains of the Constitution (Dt 17:18-20). If a king's heart weren't lifted up, he would preserve the people's rights. It would be good for a president to be as devoted to the Constitution as the king was to be to the law.

Kharash: Some of the founding fathers were afraid to establish a federal government because of the fear of it rising up to become like the strong and oppressive European governments. But they were afraid not to because any single colony could be conquered. Therefore, they very carefully set up a constitution for a government that would not become their master. They knew it could only work as long as people exercised moral responsibility.

Hakam: Free enterprise no longer functions. The government controls the economy to prevent it from flying apart.

The first step in revolution is to win the battle for democracy, according to Karl Marx. Majority rule leads to mob rule, which leads to tyranny. Democracy came into America over the years through progressive movements. It is a deterioration, an erosion of the foundation America was built upon. A democracy is the easiest government to overthrow.

A republic consists of people who are self-sufficient. They don't rely on the government for support. It is, therefore, the hardest government to overthrow. People in a republic have the concepts of inalienable rights and of limited government. A republican government is a servant ruler bound down by the same laws that bind everyone. There is no mob (majority) rule in a republic. No majority can be above the law. No one, not even a mob, can overthrow a republic. It can only be overthrown by a foreign military power.

Where the people are exercising their rights, there is actually no way to overthrow a republic, except by default when the people fail to exercise their rights. (It is like our right in the community to go to the Father in prayer. This is our right, a right the first church lost by default. This is the only way we can fall — by not approaching the throne of grace in Yahshua's name to ask for what He has put on our hearts. Heb 4:16) It is a generation that has been persuaded to look the other way that will lose its rights by default.

Today, the Constitution is taught in American schools by dialectical methods. That is why it has no force. People in America should teach their children about the Constitution with the zeal and understanding that the communists teach their children about the dialectic. Unfortunately, American schools are totally controlled by this dialectic persuasion.

All we can do is pray to allay the wrath these things deserve. If we don't pray, we will lose by default. The holy angels are the restraining influence on evil. They must be persuaded by our prayers and righteousness to remain, otherwise they will leave. We must have a sword, sharpened and polished. We must call people back to the absolute standard of the Constitution.

### Liberalism

We are the salt of the earth. We must have one voice. We have to have one mind and be perfectly one. This one voice is the sharpening and polishing of the sword.

Liberalism is in America's political process. The American public hardly knows what its ultimate goal is — the obliteration of capitalism as if it never existed. To do this, the actual history and nature of capitalistic society must be smeared, distorted, misrepresented and kept out of public discussion because the case for socialism cannot prevail in debate on the basis of logic, economics, morality, or history. Socialism can only win by deceitfulness and the moral default of its alleged opponents. That is how it is winning now.

The basic and crucial political issue in this age is capitalism versus socialism, freedom versus statism. For decades this issue has been suppressed and hidden under the foggy terms of liberalism and conservatism in this country. The goal of liberalism has been to smuggle by deceit this country to welfare statism, by means of single steps; enlarging the power of the government a step at a time, never permitting these issues or steps to be summed up so that the direction and guiding principles cannot be discerned until the ultimate goal is reached by erosion and finally there is fait accompli.

If we are not truly born of the Spirit, we cannot truly relinquish our rights and continue to give them up. That is why it says "If they left us they were not truly of us" (1 Jn 2:19). A man's possessions are his own until he gives them up.

Possessions are the big thing in the world. Individualism springs from the soil of private ownership. The good news is that you'd give up all your own possessions.

Our Papers and Prayer

Read The Remedy. The angels can't use our papers because we don't appreciate them. We don't pray for them. Newsprint is open to us. Just think of the harvest we'd see if we prayed. If you go out with tears you'll bring the harvest in. You can't force people to pray. Nothing is heard in heaven unless the Holy Spirit initiates it.

We are not supposed to work without hope or anticipation. Worship is a form of prayer. Prayer is a form of worship. The only thing that can hinder us from prayer is an evil conscience.
