Abide in Yahshua

Jn 13:34 — "I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another." Love your neighbor as yourself is the Old Covenant. The new commandment is greater than this. To love your neighbor as yourself was all the Old Covenant could live up to. Jn 13:35 — "By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." Have love. Do you have love for your brothers? Messiah had love for us. When we were yet sinners He died for us. If you received the gospel and it has cut your heart and you know that you're a sinner, then you received the Holy Spirit and you have love for your neighbor. If you have a gift for your brother you don't keep it. 1 Jn 3:18 — "Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action." This is the greater commandment. The New Covenant is a greater grace. We can do it. It is possible or we wouldn't be regarded as His friends, but as slaves.

Rom 10:11 13 — No one who puts their trust in Him will be disappointed or ashamed. This is a testimony. We cannot be saved without the word the word preached to us.

Jn 15:4 9; Rom 13:14; 1 Jn 3:6 — The difference between abiding and not abiding. Every disciple needs to know this. You can't even be trusted to be sent to work if you don't know this — how to abide. Yahshua lives in our spirit, but not necessarily in our heart, where we have fellowship with Him and don't sin. He may be in our spirit and yet we won't even think about Him. We must sense Him and appreciate Him, walking in fellowship with Him as He walked in fellowship with His Father. The road back to abiding is well marked with the sign that says, "Proceed only when you put away the hindrance of a divided heart." "If you're saved and you know it your life will surely show it." If you're not saved it is the same, your life will surely show it and your flesh has risen up. The flesh is always at war with the spirit to put up that barrier. We live in a healing envir onment. To overcome any of our many enemies is to ABIDE in Yahshua Really the only thing holding us back is SELF.

When there is a battle between the spirit and the flesh, the flesh will always win. You must not let it get to the point of the spirit and flesh battling. This is what abiding is — that we wouldn't let it get to the point of the flesh and the spirit battling. If we stay in Him we won't give in to one of the enemies. We can overcome those "six enemies," but the seventh will get you (or the eighth, etc.).

If you have love for every person in the Body except for one brother, then it means you haven't passed out of death into life. So if you don't have love for the least of the brothers, then you don't have love for Yahshua. If you take something out on a brother, you are actually taking it out on Yahshua. These people will be turned over for lashing if we mistreat a brother. WE MUST BE KIND. When the voice said to Paul, "Why are you persecuting me?" it was because he was mistreating a brother. It was the same as mistreating Yahshua.
