Israel M'susah

This evening we want to study the word *Israel* to find out what Israel really means and who Israel really is according to the scriptures we have, which have been written down for thousands of years. If you look at the Old Testament scriptures that were given to Israel, in 1 Kng 12:9 it states, "So Israel has been in rebellion against the house of David to this day." Israel - meaning the ten tribes that were separated from Judah and Benjamin. From that day - when Israel divided - until "this day" whenever this was written - and even until now, they have not been healed of this division. There has been no reconciliation. The ten tribes were scattered into Assyria. The two tribes in Jerusalem existed for a hundred or so years and then were taken to Babylon. Then only a small number came back from Babylon. Then Israel built the temple back up and existed another 500 years until 70 AD. Then Titus came from Rome and killed all the Jews - except those who escaped, or were taken captive and were scattered to the nations. Only about 15 million Jews know they are Jews today. That is quite a small amount. Many hundreds of millions of Israelites have lost their identity. They do not know what tribe they are from. Only a few Jews know that they are from Judah. And out of 15 million Jews, I think 6 million live in New York City. Our Father has opened up the U.S. for Jews to live there without persecution, so they can be made jealous by the twelve tribes (Rom 10:19: 11:14). We know that more Jews live in America than anywhere else on the earth. The Bible is very important to us to understand these days we are living in.

Israel is a blessing, a name given to Jacob. Jacob is the father of twelve sons, the tribes of Israel. These sons had a hard time – they fought; they were selfish; they had no unity, no proof that God was one (Dt 6:4). Israel is divided with no unity or peace. Only in the time of Solomon did Israel enjoy a measure of peace. It waits for another time for Israel to enjoy the peace given for the whole nation (Jn 17:22) so the world will believe the God who is one was sent to them.

Jacob's name was Israel. Who is the heir of Israel? If Israel was a blessing, who does this blessing rightly belong to?

The True Israel

When the Son of Man – the Messiah that some Jews are still looking to come – was here on earth, He was speaking to the Jews. He was speaking of a promise which was: "Whoever obeys the word of the Son of God will never see death." There will be a people who inherit that blessing, who obey the Son of God, ha-Mashiach, the Messiah. This is recorded in Jn 8:51. He was talking to the Jews. The Jews were claiming to be Abraham's descendants. There is a lot of discussion today about who is Abraham's seed. The matter is clear in Jn 8:39 – who the true Israel is, the true sons of Abraham. The Jews said in Jn 8:48 that Yahshua had an evil spirit in Him. They called Him a Samaritan, and if that was not enough, they said He had an evil spirit. Yahshua said, "If anyone keeps my word, he shall never taste death." *This* is Israel. God's possession. Those who keep His word. He pleaded with the elders of the remnant of Jacob's seed to see that only those who kept His word would inherit the blessing of Abraham. Jn 8:35 – "Truly everyone who commits sin is a slave to sin. And the slave does not stay in the house forever, but the son remains forever." Israel is not the slaves, but the sons. Not only are they sons of Abraham and of Jacob, but the very sons of Elohim.

So the promise (Gal 3:16) is that someone would be the actual seed of Abraham, the one seed of Abraham. We know that the seed of Abraham was in that man Yahshua, who according to the Old Testament scriptures was born of a virgin. He is the seed of Abraham. Gal 3:29 goes on to say that all those who are in this man are also the seed of Abraham. In Rom 9:6-8 it says, "For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel ... children of the promise are regarded as descendants." We know that Isaac was the son of the promise. He was the son of the promise through Abraham's faith. It is still through faith that we are the seed of Abraham, those who have faith in God and do not doubt. Faith is given as a gift; you cannot strive to have it. It is given as a gift. (Eph 2:8-9)

You see that Israel is Israel today only if it is twelve tribes. We know that Israel cannot be Israel except in

twelve tribes because Israel is a name given to the twelve tribes – sons of Jacob – collectively. Israel actually means the servant of God, His prince, those who will rule with Him throughout eternity over the whole universe, when our Father populates it with His highest creation – man.

Rev 21:12 speaks about Israel. Israel has twelve tribes. Israel is not that country in the Middle East because they do not have twelve distinct tribes. It does not exist today. Even Christianity (because they find it in the New Testament writings) claims to be Israel. Judaism claims to be Israel. But here (in Rom 9:6) it says they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel. So Israel is someone else. Israel is those who will never see or taste death – those who have kept the word of the King of Israel.

Gen 32:24-26 – This is an angel that Jacob strove with. Jacob knew that he was wrestling with the very Spirit of God who came at that time in the form of an angel.

There are two peoples today who boast to be Israel: the Jews in the Middle East – who became a worldly nation in 1948 – and Christianity today. Both claim this, and both claims are nullified, each for the same reason: neither of them are twelve tribes and neither one has a temple.

Judaism's temple in Jerusalem is no longer in existence. It was destroyed in 70 AD when Titus came to Jerusalem. All the records were destroyed. Most of the Jews are gone, scattered. And then they went out from their parents, and not much time passed before they forgot who they were and where they came from. The Jews are the only ones who know they are descendants of Abraham. Only a few who know remain. Russia, of course, killed more Jews than Hitler destroyed. The followers of Marx did that because he was a Lutheran at one time. His father was a Jew, and to escape persecution he became a Lutheran. Marx passed on Luther's spirit. Hitler, also, was very familiar with Luther. Hitler killed Jews because Luther had more hate for the Jews than anyone else. There are books that quote Luther on *how* he told them to kill the Jews. Luther is the father of modern Christianity today, and that spirit is in every evangelical Protestant on the earth today. It is there under a façade.

We are not Christians claiming to be Israel. Neither are we a part of Judaism claiming to be Israel. We are held separate and distinct from everyone on the earth. Christianity does not have a temple. They have no high priest. Judaism does not have a temple – no high priest. The stem's Christian parents' sins are piled up as high as heaven no matter how many times they have gone and confessed their sin to the priest. Neither do Jews have forgiveness for their sins. I heard they want to build a temple. Even if they do, our God will not be enthroned on the mercy seat because they will not find the mercy seat. They say the ark of the covenant is in Ethiopia from when Solomon gave it to the Queen of Sheba; and then when Judah was taken off to Babylon, it never returned. Israel has been incomplete since that day.

Even the New Testament scriptures that Christianity lives by says that Christianity is a defunct nation. The Church has been cut off. Their sins have been piling up ever since the first century. You can see in Rev 18:5 and Heb 10:21 that they had a temple back then when Hebrews was written to the early church.

If there *is* a people today who are having their sins forgiven, *that* is Israel. Even if they are not in twelve tribes yet, they have to have the foundation of having their sins forgiven for Israel to come into being. We have to have our sins forgiven continually (Heb 10:21).

Israel is not those who get circumcised in the flesh, but those who get circumcised in the heart. Abraham was circumcised in the heart first, *then* he was circumcised externally.

Who then is Israel? This is a vital question for all who claim to be Abraham's seed. In the next 40 years, there is going to be great issue over this one question. If Christianity is Israel they are going to have to form themselves into twelve distinct tribes. If Judaism is Israel they will have to form themselves into twelve distinct tribes in the land promised to Abraham, which they are fighting for now according to the flesh.

The Plan and Purpose of God

The issue over the title Israel and who is Israel today sets the course for how we interpret the scriptures. It determines basic theology and doctrine. Understanding the scriptures is based on the issue over the title Israel.

In the last days they will want their ears tickled. Tickling your ears means something sounds good, sounds like what you want to hear, but does not draw a conclusion or tell you how to attain to it. It does

not tell you who you are or give you the ultimate purpose of our God or what He wants for man. The question concerning Israel molds the concept of the plan and purpose of God. Everyone, every denomination, has a mold – each different from the other. That is because they are all mixed up on what the plan and purpose of our God is. Paul said that each one has a different Jesus molding them. One thing that they have in common with Old Israel is they are all fighting with one another. This question molds the plan and purpose and how one goes about being included in that plan and purpose. God had a predetermined plan before He created the universe. This plan and purpose certainly could include the creation of Israel. We love Israel. We love old Israel. But it did not turn out. But He is not finished. He is going to restore the Israel of God, the true Israel. Those who find themselves outside of Messiah, find themselves outside of Israel. That is what Paul (who was from the tribe of Benjamin) said. If you are in Messiah, you are in the commonwealth of Israel, no longer without hope and without God in the cold world. Being in the community of Messiah is being in the community of Israel, God's chosen people, His own possession.

Yahshua told the Jews back in His day that they did not know the God of Abraham. "Abraham's God is no longer your God because you departed from the faith of Abraham. You are no longer in the covenant. You are not walking in the covenant of promise," He told them. "You have the same god the world has. You're reckoned with the nations." We know the God of the world is the evil one. The whole world is in his power, carrying out his will unwittingly. Physical Israel today, like Christianity, is under the ruling force of the evil one - under the power of death. Anyone who is still under the power of the inherited death of Adam is still under the power of the evil one – still under the death sentence and their god is the evil one (Jn 8:44). The only escape from that inherited sin of Adam, the power and control of which everyone is under, is to obey the word of Messiah. That is the only way you can be set free from the ruling force of this world. Jn 8:31 - Those who follow Me and continue to follow Me will have the truth, and knowing the truth will set them free from the ruling power of the enemy and from the inherited death that you inherited from your father which goes all the way back to Adam. We will never see death. Death – when your spirit is separate from your body in a place designated for departed spirits – is so excruciating it is unmentionable how horrible it is when this happens. When you die, your conscience completely understands the repercussions of going against it. Your conscience is acutely, completely alive in death. Heb 10:31 is the death of believers.

If they obey the words of Yahshua they will not experience the first death. So they would be set free from the power of death – the power of the evil one. If they continue in His word, the truth would set them free from the evil one's power.

The only Israel today is a people whose sins are forgiven. Back then, there were thousands of Israelites. But the sincere ones, when they sinned (broke the law) they went and picked out their very best animal from their flock, the one they loved the most. They brought it to the temple and cut its throat and let the blood pour out as they leaned on it with all their weight; and then their sins would be put on that animal because it represented Yahshua, the Lamb of God who would take away the sins of the world. Those people were true Israel. They went into the bosom of Abraham. It was not an excruciating death. The others went to the excruciating agony of death. Christianity today, when they die, go to the excruciating agony of death. The same with the Jews today – because they all have no sacrifice for their sins. When the Messiah comes and everyone stands before judgment and are judged whether or not they sinned against their better knowledge, it is determined whether or not they will go to the second death. Israel will not see death of any kind because they have a sacrifice for their sins and obey His word (Jn 8:51). After the judgment, the nations who lived according to their conscience and did not continually sin against their conscience, would still have their names left in the book of life. They would go to the nations and populate the universe with man; and Israel would rule over the universe. **The Bride and the Harlots**

We learn in Rev 21:12 that Israel is twelve tribes. This is the perfect age that is coming. We see that the nations walk by the light of Israel. The harlot for nineteen centuries has put forth a false light. Old Israel was known as the wife of YHWH, but they became unfaithful. New Israel came in the first

century – **the wife of YHWH** – **and they also became unfaithful. They claim to be spiritual Israel** (they got it from Gal 3:16). We know that the church – the way it is today – has nothing to do with what Yahshua said He would establish. It is absolutely the extreme opposite of what He had in mind when He said He would build His Church (Mt 16:18). The gates of death would not prevail against Israel, His edah. The Jews believe they are spiritual and physical Israel.

So you see two harlots today. A wife that gives her love to another lover is called a harlot in the Bible. The church no longer loves Yahshua but a spirit who masquerades as Yahshua. They have received a different gospel from what Paul preached and have a different spirit from what the first church had. They have been deceived just as Eve was deceived.

Yahshua presented Himself to Israel, His own people (Jn 1:11-12). He came into His own people, the Jews, and those who were His own did not receive Him. But as many as did, He gave them the right to become children of God. He called them the children of God.

We see that the church has *become* the harlot. This is basic understanding. (Rev 18:2) She had not always been a harlot, just like old Israel had not always been a harlot. Eze 16 says they *became* a harlot. Christianity only started calling themselves Christians when they became a harlot.

I am not a Christian. Christianity is under the devil. They serve the evil one because they do not obey Yahshua. Rev 18:4 says to come out of her. We know this is exactly what Peter preached on the day of Pentecost. (Acts 2:39-40) Come out of this perverse generation – come out of Judaism. Many were God's people, and they did come out, and they became Spiritual Israel when they received the Holy Spirit because they came into Israel. But the first church waned instead of waxing. And when they waned, it became Christianity. When that happened, it lost its first love, lost its lampstand, took away Sabbaths and festivals. According to Heb 10:25-26, the sin Christianity committed was unforgivable. They failed to assemble for the appointed feasts. Israel had always enjoyed the feasts. They lost their lampstand. Then, at the council of Laodicea, they got together and the Sabbath was officially taken away. That was the official taking away of the Church as God's people because from Ex 13:31 we know who God's people really are. If they keep the Sabbath, Sabbath years, Year of Jubilee and festivals.

Everyone inside the gates of Judaism and Christianity are guilty. Their sins are piled as high as heaven. Everyone in there must come out and be baptized and become part of true Israel. He is going to make a light in order for them to see their need to become a part of Israel. That light will be the twelve tribes of Israel. This is the word of Isaiah the prophet (Isa 49:6) which our Master said must be fulfilled (Mt 5:17-18). This is the last days. When you see the restoration of the tribes of Israel, it is the restoration of all things which the prophets spoke about.

Not until He has a new wineskin to pour new wine into, can a call go out to come out of her. This is why you see thousands of communities start up, and then the people wind up worse than they were before. (2 Pet 2:20-22)

Mirth Restored

There is going to be an authoritative voice going out to the whole world with the authority of God to call people out of Babylon (Christianity today), and they are going to call them into the gates of Israel, and that gate is so narrow you cannot get through it with a backpack on. You cannot get through it with your wife, your house, your children, your possessions, your clothing. You cannot get through it with anything but your own skin and it even rips your skin. So you can understand, it is a narrow door. That means that you come right through Yahshua – that means your death. It means your old self has to die. It means everything you like to be addicted to has to go. And His life is put in us and it will grow and grow and grow until one day that people will be clothed with the sun.

Do unto others what you want them to do to you (Mt 7:12). That is what the law and the prophets said. Israel will be known by their love for one another.

Israel is a community. The whole Bible is written about Israel. To be included in Israel is to know the King of Israel. To know the King is to be included in the kingdom. The King stands at the door and lets you in. But only if you repent will he let you in to enjoy and celebrate and rejoice in Israel. If you do not repent, your mouth will

not speak His praises, because you love your life more than anything. You have to capitulate. This means that He is your King, your ruler, your Master. If you do not want that, you do not want Israel.

Isa 44:5 – "This one will say, 'I am YHWH's.' Someone will call on the name of Jacob. Another will write on his hand, 'belonging to YHWH,' and will name Israel's name with honor." That day has not come yet when you name Israel's name with honor. I want the day to come that Israel will be named with honor. I want to take the name Israel.

Gen 35:9-12 – That is the promise. This is what we are here to fulfill – to make sure that promise comes true by the grace and power of El Shaddai. He came to Abraham as El Shaddai; He came to Jacob as El Shaddai; and His power is still upon Israel to accomplish it. He is now forming a new nation.

You know why it was impossible for us to keep the feasts of YHWH 15 years ago? Because we did not know how to dance.

That is what festive means – to dance in a circular way. Our Father is going to be there to make sure we are going to have a festive time. We all know how to dance. Some of us only know two or three dances. It took us 15 years to learn how to dance. In the next three or four years we are going to have to really learn how to dance. That is what festival means. He is going to restore the dance. He is going to restore celebration. He said in Hos 2:11 - I am going to take the mirth away from Israel and give it to a people who will love me with all their hearts and love their brother, as Yahshua loved them. Festival is a time of celebration.

Messiah Has Nothing

Now we see the term Israel of God in Gal 3:16, and we know that this is His Kingdom that He will set up in the last days. He is going to establish the kingdom of Israel in the last days of this age, the latter days (Dan 2:28).

We are familiar with the dream of Nebuchadnezzar and Daniel's interpretation which YHWH had given him. Whatever verse 27 is talking about will take place in the latter days. We know the latter days do not begin until Israel is restored. And we know that Israel is not developed until "the days of the ten kings" (when the ten kings are manifested). Dan 2:31-45 — That little stone became a great mountain and filled the whole earth. Verse 39 – God does not like other nations ruling over Israel, nor does He like Israel to be idolators. When those ten kings come about, you will see ten kings of nations and twelve tribes. That dream was 2500 years ago. This is the future. The first church developed and fell and 1900 years have gone by and nothing has happened. It is like Yahshua came and died and rose and nothing happened. Messiah had nothing. Messiah was cut off and had nothing (Dan 9:26).

This Kingdom is the city that Yahshua said is the Edah — the Israel of God, the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, the light of the world. He was teaching the future apostles of the Israel of God. Mt 5:14 has not happened yet. There has never been a stone raised up. Yahshua could not have come back in the first century because the ten kings were not developed yet. His promise to return can only be fulfilled when Dan 2:44 is fulfilled. Since Messiah was cut off, He has had nothing. (Dan 9:20-26) In verse 20, Daniel was confessing the sins of His people who were scattered everywhere. We have to do the same thing confess the sins of our ancestors (Heb 3:4; 6:4-8,12).

Dan 9:25 speaks of the temple Zerubbabel built when they returned. Messiah will be cut off (crucified – treated as a criminal – treated as guilty enough to be cut off from Israel – stoned) and will have nothing (Dan 9:26), and then Titus will come from Rome in 70 AD and destroy the city and the temple. So we see that Messiah was cut off and had nothing. Christianity thinks that He has *them*. But He has not had anything – not Christianity, either Roman, Greek, Anglican, or Protestant. It says He would have nothing. Nothing has materialized yet. He told the Jews in Mt 21:43, "I am going to take the kingdom away from you and give it to a nation producing the fruit of it." You do not see the first church manifested in Jerusalem as it was 2000 years ago. He has had no twelve-tribed nation that was the light of the world. We can see in the scriptures what *is* the light the twelve tribes are to produce. He will have nothing until His kingdom comes. He did not die just to get the twelve tribes. He did not die just to get us in this age. That does

not do Him any good unless we do what we were redeemed to do. What *does* do Him good is if we would produce that light in order that the stone could come and set up His kingdom here on earth. So we are that stone kingdom. We are His servant to do His will so that this evil wicked world could come to an end. He wants a peaceful world.

David was the King over Israel. He ruled over the kingdom of Israel. This same kingdom is called the Kingdom of YHWH (1 Chr 28:5; 2 Chr 13:5). In the New Testament it is called the Kingdom of God (Eph 5:5). If you practice such things as mentioned in Eph 5:5, you will never have a part in the stone that is going to become a mountain and fill the world with its fruit.

What are those things? (Eph 5:1-5). If we do not love in the way verse 2 is speaking of, we have no part in His kingdom because we did not obey His *Word* (Jn 8:51).

Do not let immorality or any impurity or greed even be named among you. Not even a slight hint of any type of immorality. Not even a suggestion. Not even a sly word. *Not any*. No impurity; or greed. What is greed? Eating fast. We have all come from being greedy – like a dog. We are not dogs. Greed also is wanting more than you need. No filthiness. What does filthy mean? No dirtiness. No silly talk, no coarse jesting. But rather, GIVING THANKS. We should be known by our giving of thanks – mirth – rejoicing. That is the kingdom of Israel, the mountain that is going to fill the whole earth. No one will have a part in it who practices these things in Eph 5:3-4.

This kingdom is the commonwealth of Israel (Eph 2:12). You were outside but you were baptized *into* the commonwealth of Israel. If the Jews are going to be saved, they have to come into, be baptized into, the commonwealth of Israel which is made up of twelve distinct tribes in twelve distinct locations on the earth, who are expressing the unity of Jn 17:21-22. If it does not express this unity, it is all false. If we do not become that stone, then no one in here has eternal life (Mt 7:19-20).

Established by Angels

If we find ourselves 150 years away from those ten kings being raised up, then we are not the stone. We are false if our lives do not produce the ten kings coming about. If God has not revealed who a people is, they are nobody because it is God's work that does this. He is going to bring it about through the angels at the right time in history. The true church brings about the fulfillment of history. History does not bring about the church. The church brings about history. It is our godly lives that bring about the fulfillment of history. We pray for the destruction of the kingdoms, governments that would hinder that work. (Jn 17:17-23) If we do not become that manifestation on earth, that means that we will not be the kingdom — we are false. If our children are not the most godly, pure children who ever lived then we are false. If our heart does not turn absolutely toward our children — and our children's to ours — then we are false. (Mal 4:6)

But this kingdom will not be left to another people because we are determined. It is something God is doing with His Holy Spirit. He has poured love into our hearts. Let us pray that the Father's name would be great on the earth – even beyond the borders of natural, physical Israel. Pray that His kingdom would come and His will would be done.

That is the prayer of the heart of the stone kingdom. If we do not pray for this, we do not obey his word (Mt 6:9-11; Jn 8:51). He said to pray this. It will never happen if He has no people to pray for it. He will not even have a people for His name to be great in. How will the Jews be jealous and see that they are not true Israel if there is not a people where His name is great? But some Jews (or many) are going to come in the last days. Jn 17:17-23 – "Those who believe through the word may be one ... that the world may believe that the Father sent the Son." The world does not believe it today.

The throne which David was given was to be given to Yahshua (Heb 8:1-2). He is going to take over that kingdom. We see that the King has been given the throne. This high priest is the King who is sitting there, seated at the right hand of the Father right now. Did you know there was a celebration in heaven when He triumphed over the evil one and took His seat at the right hand of the Father? That was the greatest celebration that has ever gone on in the entire universe. It has never been equaled. When He returns, it is going to equal that celebration because He is going to come back for a people who are eagerly

awaiting Him – with not one blemish on them. Not one thing will cause them to shrink back from His presence. And one third of the Jews will believe on Yahshua when He returns (Zec 13:8-9); and that third of the Jews will repopulate Israel in the next age.

So where is Yahshua today? Where is His Body? Where is He enthroned? He is enthroned on high (Heb 10:12). How long is He going to stay there? He is "waiting from that time onward until His enemies be made a footstool for His feet" (Heb 10:13). When His enemies are made a footstool for His feet, then He will return. Acts 3:21 goes a little further and says that when His enemies are made a footstool, that is the restoration of all things. His enemies are the things that divide people and the things mentioned in Eph 5:5. We must put these enemies under His feet. He cannot do it where He is because He does not have enemies up there. All the enemies are right here among us. Who is the stone? Those who, through their holy, obedient lives, will bring an end to the history of this present evil age (Gal 1:4). Who are His people? Those who want and desire to be obedient. Eph 6:2 — "Children, obey your parents." The Bible is written to the children; the Holy Spirit says that.

Our Master serves in the tabernacle set up by YHWH — the stone that is going to bring an end to the whole world Who does Yahshua rule over today? Those who have come into Israel through one of the gates (Rev 21:12). What if you came in another way? You did not come in. He rules over Israel because He rules over us and we are Israel. He sat down (Heb 1:3). When you see that it says 'He sat down,' it means that He sat down to rule – He had authority. Who made the world? (Heb 1:2) Yahshua. We know that He is not an angel but the actual Son of God — divine nature. How is He going to do verse 13? Is Yahshua going to do it personally; or ar**y**ou going to do it by overcoming your worthlessness? *He is going to do it in us by His Spirit.* When all things are restored and we are perfected in unity, then He will come back.

What are angels? (Heb 1:13) They are ministering spirits sent out to give help to all of us who are to inherit Salvation (verse 14). To give a little help, in our bondage to Satan, to lead us to Salvation. Verse 3 — Being at God's right hand indicates that the work of redemption is completed and proves that He is actively ruling with God as Sovereign over Israel.

His Kingdom on Earth

Acts 7:55-56 – Yahshua is the King. What is He ruling over? Not Christianity – it is in no way like the first church. Not Judaism – if you go to Israel today, you will see them working on the Sabbath, going to discos on the Sabbath. (However, there are one third who still have it in their heart that they want to do God's will, at least the last generation of them do. They are grieved like Lot was, and they are chosen, and they will look at His hand prints and mourn. Dan 9:26 – He was cut off and has nothing. He has been waiting all that time – almost 2000 years – until the year of Jubilee comes – whenever God's people has twelve tribes of perfect unity without one hint of division, immorality, or greed. Is it possible? It is just as possible as it is for a man to rise from the dead. He rose from the dead and He can rule in His people's hearts and bring about this work (Heb 10:14). Heb 8:8-10 – *Now* it is the 'house of Israel'- twelve tribes (not ten and two).

We have not been born yet. We have just barely started. We only have barely 5 or 6 tribes. We hardly know our Father's will. We do not even know His word, which we have to obey in order to not see death. "I will put my laws into their minds and I will write them upon their hearts." The New Covenant is those who have had His law written on their hearts and minds. I'm glad that the word says that those who do not understand will have it snatched away because that makes us diligent to listen (Mt 13:19).

We know the house of Israel has been scattered into all the world. The Jews are coming back to Israel. The ten tribes are coming back to Israel. They do not even know they are Israel or what tribe they are from, except for some who are in Judah. Many of those from Judah, Jews, are in America. America is the only country who made a home for the Jews without discrimination.

They are going to see true Israel and come back into the seed of Abraham(Rom 9:8). *BREAK*

A Festive People

If you all have the constitution of Jacob, you will hold on and hang on and persevere and prevail. Even if

our Father breaks your hip, you will keep on hanging on until you are blessed. Israel is made up of mighty men like their father Jacob.

Heb 10:25 — You can see there is a day approaching; "...not forsaking their own assembling together..." was written to the first church. The first church was waning at that time. But to us it says: "Encourage one another all the more as you see the day coming about." When the countdown begins, we will start counting down new moon after new moon, every seven years, and periodic yearly feasts. Unleavened bread began the year's festivities. They were supposed to have a 50-year period – week by week, month by month, year by year, (storing up in the 6th year, enough for them to live on in the 7th and 8th year – so they could do other things in the 7th year) and then the year of Jubilee. But the pitiful thing is that Israel never celebrated one of those years of Jubilee in history. Messiah did not fulfill it when He came, but it is the Law, so He came to fulfill it. There will be a 49-year countdown for Israel. Heb 10:25 speaks about the appointed festivals, the sacred assemblies, the festivities they enjoyed when in good standing with YHWH their Father. This will prove who His house is and who is in His house. Hos 2:11 says that He is going to take the mirth away from Israel. Many groups are trying to do these feasts but there is no mirth. The only people who can have true joy are those who have had their sins taken away. You truly cannot have joy if there is something in your conscience condemning you. You cannot worship, draw near, or lift up your soul because you feel rejected.

Before the year of Jubilee gets here we are going to wax and wax in these festivals, from glory to glory – from one degree of glory to the next. The path of the righteous is like the sun, getting brighter and brighter till midda y. That is the 49-year period of waxing mirth. The more we know about His Word, the brighter and brighter we will become — and the more and more we are going to retain His Word so we can obey it. "Your word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against you, O YAH."

Paul commanded Timothy not to forsake reading the scriptures. In the beginning, we would read the Word, bathing, basking ourselves in it. That is how it is when we are not waning. He is going to restore that mirth to Israel. He is going to restore the dance – turn our mourning into dancing. It says He is going to make them mourn – take their mirth away, and then restore it.

Many groups will come back to saying 'Yahshua' or keeping feasts, but the true Israel of God is going to have mirth because they are the only ones who have had their sins forgiven.

We will see the day approaching more and more. It is going to be so wonderful as our Father shows us who we are and world history starts taking place because of our obedience because we are lifting up our prayers without wrath or dissension. Wrath sounds like such a harsh thing but it means without hard feelings, malice (Col 3:8). 1 Pet 2:5 is exactly what we do – our daily service to our Father. We are the priesthood. Verse 6 – "he who believes in Him shall not be disappointed." If you are disappointed that means that you do not believe in Him. This stone is not precious for those who disbelieve because they do not consider it precious (verse 7). Those who believe consider Him to be the most precious possession they have. They do not ever want to offend Him or grieve His Spirit (1 Jn 3:10). 1 Pet 2:9 – The reason you were chosen: "that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." Do *you* s ee the marvelous light you were brought into? We were doing all kinds of darkness that we are ashamed to even mention now. How marvelous is His light to you? [Extremely.]

It is going to get better if we keep speaking to one another. That light, the very light that is produced from His Royal Priesthood, is going to shine in the darkness so that people will see that they are lost. It is not just what we say, but it is our lives that result from putting these words into practice.

Verse 10 – "for once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." We have come home. Welcome home.

Now let's be honest – In Rev 18:5, how do we know it is not us? Because of Heb 10:21 – we have a high priest over our house who keeps forgiving our sins. Also, Heb 10:17 — "I will remember their sins no more." Jn 2:1 – He wrote these things so we do not sin, but if we do sin, we have an advocate, we have a high priest. You are part of the great illuminating voice in Rev 18:1.

Grumbling and Complaining

1 Cor 10:6 and 11 tells what Israel did. They complained and grumbled. Do you know that if someone grumbled and kept on in it, then he would be destroyed?

Can you imagine the children of Israel grumbling because they did not have water to drink? Our Father brought these things into their lives to show them their hearts. He brings things into our lives to reveal our withered condition so that we can repent from these things and have them washed away from us. They grumbled because they had no water to drink. Do you grumble when someone takes the car you wanted to use or borrows the iron and doesn't bring it back? Do you say "Thank you Father for giving me this test. I want to be patient." Or do you say, "He did it again. Henever brings it back"? The downfall of community is borrowing things and never returning them. You borrow something and think that now it's yours. You think, "Oh, he doesn't really want it. I'll keep it."

Some grumbled because they had no water to drink and they were destroyed. What is grumbling going to do to our light? Our light is subdued by grumbling. They were destroyed by the destroyer, and they had it so rough in the wilderness, and here we live better than King Solomon, and we say, "Oh, they grumbled, they were grumbling people." These things happened as an example for those living at the end of the ages (1 Cor 10:6, 11).

What if we did not have His Word? It is by His Word that we will be saved. It is hard if we do not have the Holy Spirit. But it is easy; His burden is light if we are filled with the Holy Spirit. It we are not, it is hard. **A Kingdom of Priests**

Can anyone be saved outside of Israel? Is anyone covered by the blood if he is outside of Israel? Hag 2:5 – "As for the promise I made to you when you came out of Egypt, My Spirit is abiding in your midst; do not fear." These are the words we are to speak to the sons of Israel. What if we did not have the Bible. This is what we are to speak to the sons of Israel, Ex 19:4-6. When this is fulfilled, Yahshua will have what He died for – what He was cut off for. He does not have it anywhere today, in the Catholic, Evangelical, etc. church. So He will have what He died for when He has Ex 19:5-6.

"Cut off" in Dan 9:26 – is a term meaning Isa 53:8. He was killed as a criminal in Israel. [This is a chapter that the Jews hardly know how to contend with. But they see Christianity and scoff at the idea. They say if *that* is what the supposed Son of God died for, then they want nothing to do with it.] Isa 53:

7 – He did not open His mouth; He just let them kill Him. He caused the iniquity of all of us to fall on Him.

Ex 19:5 says that if His people do not heed His voice, they will be cut off as well, and have nothing. We must obey His voice. If we will obey His voice, we will be His people. The object of our endeavor and His is the kingdom. Everything He did was for this; but "He has nothing."

We have been gathered. But we are not a twelve-tribed people yet. He cannot demand anything from just eleven tribes. If we are only eleven tribes, we are not Israel because we did not have the power to bring it about. If we were only eleven tribes, we could not have a year of Jubilee, no nation could be born, nothing could happen. You can see what we need to pray for: twelve tribes. Then we will be His own possession (Ex 19:5). These are the words that the apostles, prophets, shepherds, evangelists, and teachers are to speak to the sons of Israel.

The promise in Ex 19:5 is of course mentioned in 1 Pet 2:9 — the Old Covenant brought into the New Covenant. But still, the first church was not that holy people. They did not materialize. Unity has to be materialized, fleshed out by doing it, by living out the nuts and bolts of it.

There are so many commands in the Bible, so many demands. The Bible is not accomplishing anything if we are not twelve tribes to bring the light to the ends of the earth. The Stone Kingdom is not going to happen if we do not bring it about.

And if that is not US, I'm going to pack my bag and, I guess, jump in the river because I have no place else to go. I'm in it for the good – committed. Some people used to wear their backpack around all day waiting for someone to offend them. They were not committed – they did not come home.

Yahshua said to His disciples, 'You want to go too?' 'No, only You have the words of life. Where else can we

go?' However, the multitudes left Him.

The twelve tribes constitute, make up the ingredients or constituents of the Holy Nation, which is whole and complete. No commandment can be kept by anything less than twelve tribes that will achieve or accomplish His will. If we do not develop into twelve tribes, we will not be able to keep His commandments for any purpose (Mt 7:21). Each tribe is an integral part making up the whole. [You cannot tell Christianity to *do* anything because there are no related, component parts.] Twelve tribes are integral parts. Integrated means "constituent parts making up a component whole or unit." [In Christianity, one part is just fine without the other.] Eleven tribes cannot obey God or achieve His purpose on the earth. There can be no lacking of any part that belongs to it or it will not be complete, entire. Holy Nation comes from 'whole' – made up of real people – real unreligious people who want to obey our Creator.

We must be perfected in unity. We cannot be perfected outside of unity. One tribe cannot be perfected without the others. Jn 17:22-23 – It cannot happen without every last person being perfectly united. I cannot entertain one thought about my brother that is contrary to unity. I cannot allow anything to come into my mind and heart. Unity is absolutely impossible if I do. How is it going to happen, to be perfected in unity? We have to think about this; about what we want to do with our lives; and about how dear unity is to our Father.

A nation cannot be whole if it is not spiritually whole, unimpaired innocence and proven virtue – pure. Yahshua is talking about a whole nation of people being pure in heart (Mt 5).

When you say Israel of God, it must mean something out of the ordinary.

Rev 7:4-8 – No one on earth has the nerve to say that this is the church of the living God. Rev 7:4 indicates "twelve tribes", and that is not symbolic at all. The twelve tribes of Israel are going to be raised up at the end of days. The people of Israel are going to be brought back with other nations (nationalities). Levi is no longer a separate priesthood because we are all priests now.

To discover that this is going to happen is totally exciting. But we can become calloused because we heard it from the beginning. No one else thinks that these things are possible because they do not have the Holy Spirit. It is as certain as the Word of God, as our Master Yahshua, that we were formed into that kingdom – no doubt of what He *has done* in the very end of days (Rev 1:6). He *did* this, didn't he? *We* take hope in it. All I must do is give myself to Him. I must pray for it and thank Him for it. He did get His way. Those people were united, perfected in unity. Not just here in Sus, but everywhere His Spirit dwells. You can see here that He set up His kingdom in the last days.

Ben Nabiy – It thrills me to see the awesomeness of what our Father has in store for us – what to us He revealed by His Spirit. There are so many promises. The latter glory will outdo the former glory, outdoing Solomon — not in riches, but we will have unity. Perfected in unity. In Steinenberg, only 14 or 15 people was a light to me. I'm so thankful that we are called and chosen. I do not want ever to grow dull to these words. His age will come. Ben Chesed – When I heard that our Master, the King of Kings, Yahshua has nothing, that he has been waiting 2000 years and has nothing, and that He called me who is nothing to bring His kingdom that He is waiting for — I want to give myself to this purpose. I want to remember every morning that He waits for me. I want to change and read the Word of our Master more because He is the light. I had nothing and now I have a nation, Israel; I have a God, YHWH; and I have a King, Yahshua.

Yochanan – The day is coming when the name Israel is going to have honor – to say I am an Israelite. Ornan – It hit me, the magnitude of what is to come – that 12,000 will come from each of these tribes! And loving your neighbor as yourself is our foundation. I'm thankful that our Father continually speaks to us and brings us back to our foundation of loving one another as our Master loved us.

N'su - I'm thankful for the Word because the word is the truth. I love the word because I don't want to be the way I was in the world. The word exposes the things in my life so that I can be more like Yahshua. I'm thankful for the word because we can be priests of Elohim.

Shiminy Yom – What I heard tonight stirred me on to not grow dull and to see this life every day new, and see the purpose and vision we have before us and the great calling we have. It makes me thankful that I am chosen to be part of the twelve tribes.

Maria - The disciples said where can we go? You have the words of life. I know He has words of life for me. I

believe that they will come about.

Yathed – I'm so thankful that we can chose life. The life of our Master is contained in His Body and that life is the light of men. It is not good enough to have eleven tribes. It is going to take everybody being who they are and that we would wax in our names, not listening to the voice of the enemy. We were created to see how much our God is worth. If He is preeminent in our lives, He is going to be preeminent on the earth.

Ben Nabiy – These are the people our Father is looking for — those who are committed – who have nowhere else to go. People who commit themselves 100%. I'm thankful I can depend on them. We are not going to leave each other. He deserves what He is waiting for – His Holy Nation – His twelve tribes, His own possession.

Meshullem – I'm thankful I have nowhere else to go. I'm thankful that our Master does not want us to go to heaven but that he wants heaven to come to earth. I'm thankful He has chosen a people zealous for good deeds. I'm thankful that the whole world will see how good God is by a purified people, perfected in love, that one day they will even die for one another. A people who says no to the accuser, is in perfect unity and perfect harmony. Then Messiah will return to a people who does His will. I want to live and breathe for the stone.

Our Father is not choosing the wise but the fools of this world. There are all sorts of books written about how to live in community, etc. and here, we have no idea about anything like that, and we live together in peace and harmony.

Ahimelech – He made us priests and now we have to continue in the work He has prepared for us. I don't want to sit there and let it just be 11 tribes, but repent for not crying out for full twelve tribes.

Jehu – I see we cannot just hear, but our Father desires that we would really cry out like Daniel did. Our Father speaks to us that we would pray that His will would come about. That His stone kingdom would come. Ahavah Shua – This teaching spurred me-on to continue on without grumbling or complaining in my heart because we are not waiting for history to come about, but we are going to bring it about. Also, it effected me that if our children are not the most pure, godly children on the whole earth, we are false. And I know that my children will not be that way if I do not pass life on to them and finish in my life with what holds me back from doing that.

ha-emeq – I was encouraged by when he spoke about the angels because it was the fullness of time. The angels and our Father know the time and when it was the time the ten kings were going to be raised up. But He didn't start right at the same time the ten kings did. He came right before so we would have time. Yoneq asked me today, what if we didn't have time to start dancing and now all of a sudden we had to start the race? But, years ago our Father put in on our heart to start dancing. He started a little new shoot about 20 years ago and started to prepare a new wineskin. We had to be prepared to be a people to keep the feasts. If we would have had to start back then we might have been eating pork and have been just like the Gentiles. But He has already prepared us and our children have grown up in a proper environment. And now he can pour His wine into new wineskins. It did not come about that we saw Acts 2 and then said, 'OK, now we have to live in community.' But it is a living thing. Like a plant that shoots up and starts to grow. A normal thing. I'm thankful for the work He has done in us that we would grow normally into this. Because it is not that we are just going to play Israel. 'OK, now let's play Israel. Jehu, you play Jehu.' That is not how it is. We *are* Israel. We were born for this purpose, and we become what we were born to be.

We did not know Acts 2 existed, but we were living in community and then we saw it and said, "Hey, that's like us here." He has prepared us, even bringing musicians in from the world.
