

For Women Only — *(for wedding preparation)*

The scriptures teach us to make love, but not *how* to make love. This is very serious. Gen 2:18 — YHWH said, “It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him.” Verse 20 — “...No suitable helper was found for him.” Gen 2:20-24 — This is for women only, it is not for the men. I don’t think I’ll tell them what we discuss. Some of them might hear some things about it, but I don’t think it is good to teach it to both together.

It is not good. What is not good? It is not good for the man to be alone. Verse 20 — because no suitable helper was found, He had to make woman. There is something in this we have to know and understand if we are going to be a suitable helper. The final act in making man complete in YHWH’s own image — because *sh* was incomplete — was to make woman for him.

Ish (man) was incomplete without *Ishshah* (woman). His *being* demanded a counterpart. (*Being* is the existence of, the presence here, a *demand*. Everything that he was demanded to be released, liberated, set free, activated.) As he was alone, all his potentials and capacities that our Father put into *Ish* laid dormant, like yeast that will sit in the refrigerator indefinitely, but put into warm water is activated. *Ishshah* is what releases and liberates and activates all these qualities and potentials in *Ish*. What distinguishes man’s spirit from the rest of creation is that his spirit is able to be in union with the Holy Spirit (Ruach Ha Kodesh). But as a physical being he needed another physical being to correspond to him, another physical being whose spirit could also be in union with the Holy Spirit. He could love, give life, communicate, but where was the suitable recipient of the output of the bodily form of the Creator?

Ish demanded a counterpart: *Ishshah*. In order to make him fully human and *realize* his humanity, *Ish* needed *Ishshah*. (*Realize* does not just to mean mentally grasp something, but to bring it into being.) Adam had to absolutely submit himself to YHWH in order to be operated on, to be completed. The final act in creation was to supply man with what he lacked. *She* is the counterpart of *he*. There is *Ish* — *Ishshah*. Gen 1:27 — man is made male and female. Eve came out of his side to suit him, to be a suitable helper. Thus *Ish* and *Ishshah* are made in the image of God. You couldn’t say Adam alone or Eve alone was made in the image of God, but both together were in His likeness. (*Ish* was incomplete without *Ishshah*. That means *Ish* and *Ishshah* together, in unity, are the physical manifestation of everything the Creator is in His spirit. Talking to feminists this answers the question: “Well, why does God have to be a *he*?” Answer: “He is not. He is what male and female together in unity represent.”)

The final act was to supply a “helpmate.” What did Adam need in order to be fully human? A suitable helper. Without the female, man could not be fully human or realize his humanity. He was alone. It was not good for him to be alone. Are you a suitable helper for your husband? Or is he alone in some thing? Can a husband still be alone? Is that a contradiction? Why did he get married?

The first reason for marriage is companionship — suitable company. Being alone is being without suitable, harmonious company (harmonious fellowship, perfectly adapted, the part you can’t be without, your counterpart).

Our Creator designed marriage to keep man from being alone. Did you know that? Because it is not good for man to be alone. What does *alone* mean? Now you’ll see why every woman was born and came into being. Man has a need. *The wife is created from birth to fulfil a need: so he won’t be alone*. *Alone* means without aid and support. In what? What did he need a suitable helper for? *To rule!* To provide a headship which she needed, the beginning of government. But what does she supply in her suitability? She aids and supports. *Alone* means without aid and support. In his personality or humanity he needed a helper to do something, to support his personality. Adam had mental faculties, but he needed a stimulant, a catalyst — something that would let loose or put into action his psychological, mental, social, etc., aspects.

This is her ministry to him that brings forth these aspects. She reaps the benefit of the relationship, if she does

what she is created to do. A woman stands around and encompasses a man; she satisfies every need in every aspect of his life. This is her ministry. He would be dead or useless without that woman.

A man and a wife are to be one flesh. Integrated with each other's life and personality. One spirit, soul, and body — the whole person, one flesh, one being. When we get married, do we become one flesh with our spouse? When? At the point of sexual intercourse? It is not necessarily at the marriage ceremony.

The kiss is our first act of willingly submitting ourselves (Ps 2, kissing the Son). The wife kisses the husband. *She* takes the initiative to be what he needs to complete him in his psyche — mental, social, etc., development. In what aspect is your betrothed alone, needing you as his helpmate? You must be *fully* what you were created to be. It takes the woman to fulfill the need so that together they could be *man*.

They are not necessarily one because of sexual intercourse. Even physically if a man is joined to a prostitute, they're one flesh, but this is not so with your personality. These days in the world, sex is just a passing whim and means nothing.

They are not one with each other if in any area they are still alone. In what aspects do you think about encompassing him? She is the helpmate, not him. Who's the helpmate? Are you demanding him to be the suitable helpmate? (To meet all your needs and fulfill all your desires?) *She is the helpmate! All of her needs are fulfilled by her being what she was created to be.* You thought it was his ministry to you. But it says HE was incomplete — he needed her!

Suit means fits perfectly, adapts, accommodates, is becoming to. (It is not becoming to a disciple to do certain things.) *Suit* —to meet the needs and desires of, to agree, be in accordance with, to complement, to please, concord, to be becoming to, *suitable*.

When you were betrothed here, the Edah said amen to your marriage. If we said amen to something our Father doesn't say amen to, we've done it in the flesh. Our *yes* must be *yes*. Our *no* must be *no*. Anything else is from the evil one.

When our Father joins you together, you are joined. You're suitable. There are no excuses. **YOU CAN DO IT!**

You meet all his needs and desires. You live to please him, helping him in accordance with him, not as a thorn in his side. It was Adam who needed her help in his spiritual needs.

The central aspect in the relationship is the act of love. It is not just a sexual relationship, but it is something you look forward to with delight. It is love. He provided all the physical pleasures to go along with it for your own psychological need. It is a release. It is the central part of your relationship. You can't try to meet all his other needs and push that one under the rug.

Our Father so designed every human being with intricacies that give you pleasure. Sexual intercourse was intended for pleasure. And that's what you want to give your husband. And *he will want to know that you have pleasure or else it will just become a ritual to him.*

This is why we've tried to have family nights. We have to schedule time for each other. You can't just work so much and never have time alone together where people can't hear you, with no children around. The older you grow the better your relationships should become. We have to have time without weariness, distractions, and headaches, or we'll become unhappily married. We must have time alone. We have to thicken the walls a little. We're going to have to rearrange our houses.

How do you become a suitable helper? What does he need? What does he need to hear and know from you?

Do you think he'd like to hear that you like him? How wonderful he is with children, in his work, the things he says, the grace he has... You can think of a thousand things. Only think of him, not yourself. He'll think of you.

If YHWH put you with him, you have that ability and the talents. If you don't use *all* of your talents, you are not worthy of the kingdom.

There seems to be a conflict. It seems like being married would prevent you or interfere with using all your gifts for you have to spend time on your family, children, household, etc. But here we are commanded to use all of our talents. What does this mean? Seek first the kingdom. *Kingdom* means rule and reign. We need to first seek to fulfill our husbands, so that they can rule. We need to submit our gifts to them and let them decide where and when to use our gifts on the Body. Don't come to him saying, "I have to do all

these things; I can't spend time with you," and let him feel that he is second in importance, because you are so needed in the Body, getting your worth out of that. But let him know how important it is to you that his needs are met.

Your gifts are his to give. Let him rule them and give them. And he will be satisfied giving up his life when he gives you up instead of being under the pressure of having to do it, because you say so. Otherwise it is like extolling your ministry to the Body above his. If you are not first fulfilling him, he can't function like he is supposed to.

You need to use your talent of being a suitable helpmate. Every wife has this talent. So let the first fruit of your talents be *his*, as a suitable helpmate, so that *he* can be fulfilled. Then he can give your gifts. It is really emasculating to let your husband know what he needs to do (letting you go to this and that meeting, etc.). You have ALL the talents. Use them so he won't be alone. Use them wisely, perfectly, with poise, like a skillful lover of his person.

EXTOL HIS ATTRIBUTES. *Attributes* —his inherent character. Build him up in that way. He was alone until you came along and helped him in the way he could be helped. Your encouragement, what you say about him, you complement him. His sensitivity, his looks, all the ways he is. You BUILD on that. On ANYTHING you see in him. If the man is not fulfilled or not built up by the wife in any part of his life, he is still alone in that part.

Lk 7 — Be honest, in what part is he alone? If you are the one who will be surrounding him (Jer 31:22), what part is he alone in? This has been waiting for the New Covenant. Jer 31:22 could only happen when Ruach ha Kodesh, the Spirit, the very person of God, came to live in the spirit of a woman. But it is not automatic. It is something you have to learn about and pray much about. Is it spiritually, mentally, physically, where you must learn to fulfill your husband?

How do you complete him in his spiritual needs? By praying for him, appreciating his godliness, his headship. You have to really COMMUNICATE with him. Show him by your attention and appreciation.

Some married men I know are still alone. You can tell by talking to them. It is obvious, because they don't hide it. They talk about it. The wife may be alone, too, because she is not fulfilling her ministry. She'll be alone in that same area. But it is the wife's initiative — HE NEEDS YOU! Yahshua needs you!

So in what area are you alone? That is the aspect in which you must aggressively and prayerfully seek to fulfill him. Being alone is a picture of spiritual death. In Messiah we come alive in every aspect. Abundant life means full of life.

The wife is the helper. The wife is the spirit's instrument to help her husband. He uses *people* in our lives to fulfill and to minister to us, not just Ruach ha Kodesh alone. (Or else we could say we need the Spirit and no other.) The Spirit doesn't bypass the wife (He doesn't comfort, encourage, etc., your husband without you), but he allows her to fulfill her function. The Spirit empowers the wife. Even in the nations many great wives have built up their husbands.

Your husband has a need. You are to complete his need.

Gen 3:16 — "Your desire will be for your husband." Her attraction — what kind of desire is this referring to? What drew you to your partner? It wasn't everything else besides sex (how godly he is, what a good teacher, etc.). It's sex... it's the central thing — it's holy and pure. It's physical attraction. She desired his emotional, social, and mental happiness — as well as her own of course. Her desire is for his headship, the security he brings. Her satisfaction is fulfilling him.

Some couples have a good marriage. But their marriage remains incomplete and unfulfilled if she doesn't know how to please him. She is only unfulfilled because she doesn't fulfill him (please him in their sexual relationship). She was created to fulfill his need.

We are teaching these things to you now, as a new bride, because you are an integral part in our Father's purpose being accomplished. We want you to understand what you are entering into, what your purpose and vow is, as a wife. Both husband and wife are unfulfilled if *Ishshah* doesn't know how to fulfill *Ish* in their sexual relationship.

Are you the responder or the initiator? Some women do take a long time to respond sexually, to feel anything.

But you are not just the responder. You are ready for him, you think about it during the day. Are you looking forward to sexual intimacy? Are you ready? Wife, your desire is for your husband, in all his ways socially, spiritually, mentally. He responds to your desire. You too, will be fulfilled by your ministry to him. She came from his side to remain by his side to fulfill him. She lies perfectly next to him, by his side.

Remember: *You are created for him — he wasn't created for you!*

That is why you were created. Do that and you complete mankind. Give yourself to him without reservation. For a lot of women this might be hard to take because of their past relationships. But what we see is that worthlessness is the main enemy. We all suffer from living in a world that extols the fantasy of the perfect, beautiful, flawless woman. It is easy for us, even the virgin brides, to think we are too fat, too skinny, too short, too scarred, have stretch marks, wrinkles, the wrong shape of nose, etc., for our husbands to be able to enjoy us and take delight in us. But this self-consciousness will hold us back and makes us want to hide or quickly get it over with. Being affected by this and giving into this spirit is eating from the tree of knowledge of good and evil (though it is good to be thin and bad to be fat). It puts our eyes on ourselves and holds us back from love, instead of being innocent and eating from the tree of fellowship and life, and trusting our husbands when they tell us they love us.

We are so thankful to realize our Father's healing. For those of us who come in from the world, He actually wants to not only forgive, but even to restore the years to us that the locusts have eaten away. We are the stem. We are being healed now for the sake of so many other women to come that have suffered even worse than we, having experienced sexual abuse and perversions, etc. These women will hate the word *love*, hate to even think about a physical relationship. Their only hope is to see women that are fulfilled, at peace, full of gratitude and love towards their husbands. This will draw them to us, give them hope, and they'll come to us for help. And then, when we tell them what love is, our life and compassion will win their hearts and heal them too.

The ultimate expression of your love for him is your sexual relationship. Your physical relationship depends on all the other things being fulfilled. The ultimate expression of your love for him is in the bed. Let your bed be undefiled. The bed is where he knows that you belong to him, that you are his possession. Just be in bed with him, enjoy being with him — everything else will take care of itself.

Woman completes man if she is doing what she is created to do. She was created to make him complete. If she does not do this, she might as well have not lived. Don't say, "I can't do it!" **YOU CAN DO IT.** That is why our Father put you there. Pray. It is going to get you so close to your Father in heaven; He will be upon you to do it. Man is made whole only by what woman does best: that is to surround and encompass him, not in menial chores, but as a suitable helper.

It is in your daily behavior towards him that will measure the extent and depth of the pleasure you find in making love together. Your sexual relationship reflects your emotional companionship together. Every meaningful and enjoyable sexual relationship begins with a loving, respectful, attentive attitude days before. Our marriages have to go day to day from glory to glory. There are no divorces. We thrive on learning. Your desire is for him. You help your husband. To help him in sexual aspects is to *communicate*. This can be hard. We cannot think it is bad or sin to communicate while you are making love. It has been put into some of us that sex is bad and we feel guilty, that it is just tolerated and it is bad to have pleasure from it. But in Yahshua, as we train our children and youth about sexual things and as we prepare couples for marriage, we teach them what is normal. Our Father gave us taste buds because He wants us to experience pleasure in eating. He created our bodies because he wants us to experience sexual pleasure, communion between husband and wife.

It helps your husband so much if you tell him he is pleasing you. Tell him clearly what is pleasing you — what you want. You are not being selfish. If he doesn't know that he is pleasing you, pretty soon he will be impotent. Year after year will go by and finally he will ask himself, "What am I doing?" He would be afraid to say it to his wife. He would feel rejected.

Tell him clearly what stimulates you, what arouses you, and what you need. A woman is so designed that the point that gives her feelings, the clitoris, is where the penis doesn't even touch. However if you are a human

being you need to have a sexual climax. YHWH made woman this way. He didn't just go to the point of making this thing, this sexual organ, the clitoris, in its intricacy for nothing. Our Father made you to experience sexual pleasure. Your husband will love it when you have maximum pleasure. Tell him when you're ready; let him know with your hand.

Wives must understand that if a man doesn't have an erection for at least twenty minutes, then his climax is reduced to a mere feeling, rather than deeply satisfying his emotional, physical, spiritual, and psychological needs. As skillful lovers women have to use wisdom on this. There may be times when a man can't hold himself that long. But our hope is that we would help our husbands to take time to ensure more satisfying release.

In the community we learn to do it quick — right before someone knocks on the door or the baby wakes up. (It's the greatest privilege to be the first ones to live through these problems in community.) What we need is emotional release. In your marriage relationship, you will learn to know what you want and when you want it. Your husband is not supposed to go there, to the clitoris, first. It is the last place. You have to build up to it first.

YHWH intended marriage to meet the basic human need of love and companionship. A helper corresponding to him. A helper alongside of him. You have to help your husband. Show him — he will show you what he wants and likes. That is what communication is. 1 Cor 13; Mt 7:12 — The golden rule and the standard of love is: do unto him as you would have him do unto you.

You are his companion. A companion is one employed to live with or serve another. You are to keep him company, not him keep you company. All your needs will be met in this way. He needs you being sociable, helping and standing alongside to complete and make him whole.

There was no other creature found suitable, so she was taken from his side — not as a maid. A friend of mine once said, "I can hire a maid, but I married her to love me." There is a mutual need. The woman has got to be the aggressor — TAKIV — in meeting his needs. Being sociable, serving, meeting his social needs. **Sociable** — inclined to seek to be a companion, conducive to friendship, pleasant social relationship in loving and serving. You like to be with him.

Gen 2:23-24 — Becoming one flesh is established through sexual union, but is much more than sexual intercourse. It establishes and creates the union of the whole person. The spiritual and mental interrelationship is more than just physical. One flesh — *flesh* means the whole union. It establishes a bond of the whole personality, which is fundamental in the sealing of the indissolubleness of this marriage, a bond that makes that relationship indissoluble — an eternal bond.

When we come into Messiah, we are one with Him. Mt 19:6 — There is no divorce, unless you connect yourself with another person. Israel won't be married in the next age; we'll be married to Messiah. Eph 5:20-31 — You won't have your husband in the next age. It's only for this age. This is your chance to be a wife ... in this age. If a wife is submissive, both will be fulfilled. If she is, then there is no way she'll be unfulfilled. That is the secret: kiss the Son. It's not subjugation. Our Master was happy in His submission to His Father. Anything else will be hard and not fun. We are miserable when we hold ourselves back. We are not happy when we are not submissive. Defer to him in every way, respect him.

Jer 31:22 — Take note of the highway you take... return Virgin Israel, your habitat... How long will you wander? A new thing... A woman will encompass a man. She surrounds him and gets the benefit, defers to, respects, restores his rightful dignity.

Every time a little girl is born there should be rejoicing because of her purpose. She knows her purpose. She can rest assured of her salvation.

1 Tim 2:11-15 — You should learn in quiet submissiveness knowing how and when to shut your mouth. You will know when to be silent. To serve man is to be a help, even if you are not married. A single woman has only one goal: to please our Father in heaven and to serve man.

The Sovereign will do a new thing on earth. A woman will tenderly embrace and with unfailing love, without restriction, form a circle completely around her husband (every side covered, tenderly and compassionately enveloped). She has the ability to do this. It was given to her from birth.

The New Covenant makes a distinction between women in the world and us. There is a bold contrast. We are reigning with Him. We are ruling over His enemies.

Some notes that we can give private instruction from, with wisdom (see also the teaching “Preparing the Bride for the First Night):

There are some things that are obviously forbidden: anal sex ... you never want to transfer the one to the other. It is not good. It is not designed for that. Oral sex is debatable. Nothing in the Bible says you can't do it. What is proper? What does it lead to? If you get into it, you begin to depend on it. You can't be fulfilled any other way. You have to limit yourself. But in pornography, it is a big thing. The teenagers now all do it. In the world it is an alternative to getting pregnant — thirteen and fourteen year olds, they are the ones who use it. It can't be a fulfillment in itself. And this thing about the semen ... of course in the law it only says you have to wash really well whatever it gets on. Perhaps as a certain stimulant ... but the negative results of it would probably say it is better if you can do it normally — manually.

It must be according to the mutual conscience. Don't overstep or override the conscience of the other one. Each person has to determine what pleases our Master. Some things you do, you don't feel quite right about, or is this my Puritan upbringing? We have to learn what the Holy Spirit teaches us about this after a few years. Due to discharges at times, it would not be proper. You all know about that, don't you? There are many things you can do to stimulate each other without resorting to oral sex. The blood is on my hands if I say yes or no according to what I do myself. I can't release your conscience in that. I don't think it is appropriate for the body fluids to be in the mouth. That is not what it is made for. Some people say Song of Solomon encourages it. I can't see it. If you can do without it, by all means, do, because it leads further to an unnatural dependency. The wife is the best teacher on manual stimulation to bring her to a climax. The vagina is not supposed to be dirty. Germs are in the anus and there could be germs from the mouth.

Part II

Gen 3:16 — To Eve He said: “I will greatly intensify your pain in childbirth.” It was Eve's failure to obey what our Father commanded through her head that brought on this discipline. She was deceived. Evidently she knew the command (Gen 2:17). Gen 3:16 has true meaning and has accomplished its purpose. Eve failed to complete man, to do what she was created to do. Her refusal to obey her head, Adam, to receive his instruction and be a suitable helper, submitting to him, came against YHWH's command for Adam to rule. 1 Cor 11:3 — The kind of submission our Father wants is man to Yahshua and woman to man just like Yahshua's submission to His Father. If you are not in this order there is no way you can be in Salvation. Out of this order is totally out of order, because there is an anointing that teaches us this.

Jn 10:17-18 — We can see the wonderfulness of our Father, our Master, and of man and woman through her submission. The submission our Master had was because He wanted to, not out of subjugation. Subjugation is forced obedience. Yahshua had the Spirit (Ruach Ha Kodesh) in his heart. “The reason my Father loves me is because I lay down my life, that I may take it up again.” Submission is when you give yourself willingly out of your own free will from your heart. If you as a wife would understand what you are doing from the very beginning of your marriage, if submission would come from your own free will, it would save a lot of hardship.

When no one forces you and makes you do it — it is submission. Paul tells slaves to obey in the same way. Châm was to be a wonderful helper to Shem. It would have been a beautiful thing if man had done it right. Châm would have been there, helping with the children, living together in some kind of community setting. Châm is a wonderful servant. He wasn't really supposed to rebel and gain his freedom. There is a terrible war now. The curse has not been lifted off Châm, except in Messiah.

Women don't need to ever want to be free, because you are free. You are free to submit. Out of your own free will, will I submit. This makes your husband love you. It wasn't subjugation.

When it says “rule over you,” what does it mean? The exercise of authority, in which security is found. *Ru*

le means to lead straight. If your husband is listening to Yahshua he can lead you straight. It is a guide or standard for conduct or a regulating principle. Now you know your purpose for living. You are to help him rule over you. There is no love involved in subjugation. There would have been no love in beating His Son to get him to die on the cross. The husband's rule over her is made the natural outcome of her fulfilling her purpose.

All women who are blessed even have an instinctive predisposition to do that. Châm does too, but it has been perverted. Shem has done Châm wrong and man has done woman wrong. But it is good, because the world is bad and we need to have a platform to be light to the nations, a standard. Make them see they're wrong by how we do it. With Châm it has become haywire and backfired and with women too. It is unattainable to strive for equality or superiority. It is striving for the wind. The Muslims want to dominate the earth by having babies, because the whites have stopped having them. They hate and want to annihilate the white man. Christians have been perverters of the world, trying to make the blacks equal. They can't, because the curse is not lifted. We've got to have a platform to preach from. We have it. Please understand Isa 49:6-7. We are in Salvation, but we're beginning to realize it more and more. YOU WOMEN ARE THE KEY OF ISA 49:6, the restoration of all things.

It is up to Eve to bring it about. Our Master took away the enemy's authority over us so we could make up for what Eve did. She is sorry she did it. Yahshua was sacrificed before the foundations of the world. He had us in mind at the end of the age.

My sheep hear my voice and know me. I lay down my life for you. My sheep are you (Jn 10:16).

You were inclined wrong. But now you are inclined in the right direction. Mt 25:34 — Those who help us, have a kingdom prepared for them (those destined for the nations). They are good people. In fact, they are better than us (because they listen to their conscience; most of us did not). We're inclined toward our created purpose.

For us it's our only chance. If we had kept on going out there, many of us would have wound up going to the second death.

In the New Covenant it will never be done any other way. There is no other age for woman to be in total submission to man. Out of your own free will, because you won't be married in the next age. It's not that you won't be like the angels, because they don't marry. We will be too busy ruling the universe to marry.

We're going to love the nations. They'll be so glad to see us, they will be rejoicing. We'll act just like the Father would if He had a Body. We've got to be perfect as He is perfect now. We've got to be perfect in talking to outsiders. What would God do, if He had a Body? What would He do if He were in the store? Would He talk to a brother or sister or talk to outsiders? Read Mt 5:48 and read backwards — that's how you start being perfect as He is. We are "maturing." We won't be maturing if we don't talk to outsiders. We have to have a burden for them. We've got to do it all. Fulfill the law and all the prophets. He has a body to fulfill it all

The way we do it is love.

So here we are, we've been born and it's time now to run. We have the ball. Now you know what you're created for. There ought to be a change in your life. That's why we have all this knowledge.

Don't be deceived like Eve, your mother. She was deceived. Don't be deceived like Eve. The second Eve was the Corinthian church (1 Cor 11:3; 2 Cor 11:3). Eve was deceived. Eve was created with the predetermined disposition to be submissive. And also it was told to her by Adam. But she went against it, so she had to be told by YHWH himself. So she had to suffer. We have to suffer pain in childbirth for her disobedience.

With the New Covenant in her heart and mind she now has the opportunity to do it over again. 1 Tim 2:13 We have an opportunity to clear our name for Yahshua's sake. "If I were a woman, I would be so happy to wear a headcovering." The husband lets you wear it to show everyone your submission. Be glad you don't have to wear a headcovering of polka-dots, but one of your choice. The *privilege* ours for the sake of the angels, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and for the husbands, and for Eve's sake. Do you see your chance? She is in the cloud of witnesses. Even after Eve fell, she gave birth and said, "With the help of YHWH I brought forth a man!" (Gen 4:1). She continued to honor YHWH for his help.

We know Adam and Eve wanted to do right. They had Seth and from him came the line of Noah, of which only eight people were left who were not deceived. And so here we are at the end of the age. Know who you are!

Also there was no bitterness in her, that she had to suffer in childbirth.

Eph 5:22 — Wives submit to your husbands as to Yahshua. Would you submit to Him any more than to your husband? You hypocrites! If you did, He would know your heart; you are a pretender. It's feigned obedience. Eph 5:22 is the good news of the kingdom, because by being obedient to this you won't die, but enter the kingdom. Are you going to enter the kingdom if you don't submit to your husband? No! We're saved, our names are in the Lamb's Book of Life; but we will die if we are not obedient to His Word. We die temporarily, but He wants us to learn to do it by getting a few spankings and live.

We've got to know His word and keep it. We've got to teach this to our children. If you are not submissive to your husband, you are not submissive to Messiah. How do we not taste death? By obeying His Word (our husband's word). Your husband washes you with the water of the Word. Women are saved by the discipline of the pain of childbearing. In the next age we won't be submitting to husbands.

The length of your labor is getting shorter as you live right, have a good conscience and be obedient to the midwives' directions when you get pregnant. You can see the results of the fall diminishing as we go.

It will take much anguish on our part to produce the Male Child. She was wreathing in pain. Rev 12:2 — She cried out in pain. That's us. We're the mother. We all have a part in giving birth to this child. As soon as we give birth to the Male Child, we're just about to be killed — no food, no electricity, the beast oppresses us, but we send them out and then the woman is taken away into the wilderness. We will send them out and this will distract the government and allow us to flee.

The Male Child is to ascend to the throne. He is pure and holy with the authority of Yahshua. He goes out to prophesy, not with a sinless nature, but having been raised right. We know, when we pick that child, we'll offer him up to die. To be burned by the sun, etc. As soon as we bear that child, we're through. We raised him up to about twenty-one years. We have to be in perfect harmony and submission in our love for one another or else two women will be grinding, one will be taken, one will be left. The Stone will be totally formed. The dead Male Child will be raised. People will be left in the wilderness to be judged. The shout at the last trumpet will not come from the angel, but it is the Male Child by the power of the angel, guarding the children, guarding the Edah. When He comes, we are all going to shout.

That's why we're living. This is our purpose and it's real and WE have everything to do with it. WE are the helpmate. Eve is cheering us. We don't have great feelings, but that's good. It wouldn't be real. It's no good if we just have feelings. He is testing us to see who really loves Him, not in our own goose-bumped flesh.

Yerusha: So he can know our hearts are in His way.

D'rorah: The relationship between Châm and women is that they both uncovered their heads. Châm, his father and woman, her husband. Châm can't fight for superiority. All he can do is submit to Shem. Woman can't fight for superiority. **All** she can do is be covered by her husband. The only way they can have peace is to submit — to Shem, and woman to man.

Ruth: The Male Child will be produced through much anguish. That must be why I suffer so much. I was raised so leniently. It takes so much to do what we do and learn the ways He has for us. This is just the beginning of our learning to suffer and our suffering.

Rose: The discipline is to have much pain in bearing children. And in the restoration you said that as we were being healed and living right in being obedient to the things that were given to us in our pregnancy and keeping a good conscience, that the labor would become shorter and less painful. It seems like the suffering that we are going through now is preparing us to be able to endure the great suffering ahead that will bring forth the Male Child. If we are properly prepared now, then we will be able to lead the way through the pain to bring about Salvation. It seems like this is another aspect of women being saved through childbirth.

Thousands and thousands will come in from the outside. The time will come when we will be built upon.

Elizabeth: Our Father doesn't always directly build up man. The Holy Spirit uses woman as His mouthpiece or the vehicle to bring encouragement and love to man. This is why it is so vitally important, that we strive to be in communion with the Holy Spirit and not the fallen flesh.

Rose: I was really thankful that you said we don't have to have great feelings, because I don't have

great feelings. When people stand up and share and they tremble and cry, I get really condemned because I don't have feelings like that, or passion when I share my heart. But I know there is something in my heart that is real. I just don't know it through my feelings. Obadiah shared at the breaking of bread that his wife prophesied to him that only through great suffering would the prophetic voice be raised up. Nothing can really effect someone unless it has been experienced. It is only the deep sufferings we go through that can reach a person's heart. And the suffering that you go through is only bringing this about in your lives. Our Father is not interested in a good performance. He wants to reach man's heart through us. You are no different than the rest of us. We all suffer in our own ways.

Yachebed: Isa 49 — We were all called that we could rule. It's only going to be through Him that we are going to endure and bring forth his glory. I've continually shown myself that I cannot do it in my own strength. We have to continually remind each other of our calling.

Many women's rebellions were secret, where some were an open book. It is better to have open rebellion and deal with it than secret rebellion that is still going on and liable to explode any time.

Seke: I was afraid to speak because I too don't have a lot of feelings. But when I heard what was said about good feelings, it set me free. I received a whole lot. Strife in woman in all aspects is gone forever. We don't have to strive FOR ANYTHING! We don't even have to strive to put everything into our children so they will be just right. All we'll have to do is just die and rest. That is why we will have such a loud shout: because we have suffered. I hate suffering! I HATE IT! I HATE TO DIE. I squeal and squirm and my brothers and sisters have to lay me down and pull my arms apart and NAIL ME to the cross ... we don't even have to strive to die! Just lay down and rest and our brothers and sisters will help us. But as time goes on, it won't be so hard for us to die. But we will fall in love with our Father because it happens to us. I've been the worst! Everyone knows, but it doesn't matter. We just have to be humble and let it happen. I've been through enough sufferings to know that I don't need to strive and struggle anymore. I can just die. Trust. Rest and wait. The shout will be SO LOUD. It makes me so thankful for my salvation.
