

Feast Day

Acts 26:1 — Paul is talking to King Agrippa about the vision he experienced. Verse 6 — The God of our fathers — the fathers of old. Paul was talking in his day at the start of the hope to attain the start of twelve tribes. This hope is put off until this day. Rom 9:29 — Because the church became like Sodom and Gomorrah, He would preserve a seed. Then that seed will take root and sprout a growth. Then, Rev 7, in order that the light of God would go as a witness.

Rev 21 — Twelve tribes of Israel. Without entering into one of those gates, you cannot be saved. Many don't want to be saved. Yahshua stands at the gate of each of those tribes; you must go through Him into one of the gates to be saved.

Eph 1:1 — God's people, that is, those trusting in Him (Eph 1:1-14). Verse 10 — When the time is right (union and communion). Verse 11 — Counsel: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit came together to choose who would be saved. Those who are called decide whether to accept the call and give up their life. Verse 13 — put your trust in Him.

We are gathered in our Master's name—the ones called and chosen—those He knew, who would receive Him.

We come to the feast day to give Him praise and honor. Never start any festival without giving Yahshua *all* praise and glory. We will speak of the twelve tribes, of Eph 1, of what we are doing and where we are going. Start by reading of the word (1 Tim 4:13). Rev 1:3 — Blessed are those who read and hear.
