

Married Men's Meeting

It is dawning on us who we are. He is raising us up in the twelve tribes and bonding us together. The enemy will do everything he can to stop it. But we know it will happen because of Rev 21. We are joint-heirs of the whole universe. Our Father needs families and children. We must rule over all things. The husband rules over his wife. She is submissive — he doesn't lord it over her. True rulership is having subjects who are submissive like our Master.

What we are talking about today is for our young virgins, our seed. This is especially for them in preparation for marriage, but what we have to say will help all of us.

Everything in the world is communicated by a sexual spirit. The only way we can overcome sexual spirits is by not allowing them into our brain. Your brain is your biggest sex organ. Sexual intercourse might be instinctive, but we do not want to keep making mistakes. We have had people who have been married and did not know what to do on their honeymoon. No one loved them enough to share with them. One woman was frightened when she saw her husband's erection because she knew nothing. Women have gotten cystitis and not known what to do. If we are not communicating we are not loving.

When you share something with your child that he has never heard, it forms a bond with him. If you are embarrassed to discuss sex with your children then you have a demon that keeps you from discussing it. When they ask, this is the time to answer them with what they can handle. Children will go and find out what they want to know anyway. But if *you* tell them it bonds you and your child together. If you will not share these things with your child then you have *lost* your child — if they can not come to you about anything that might be on their mind.

We want to eliminate these bad experiences on our children's honeymoons. The honeymoon sets the pace for their entire married life. We can't have anything without crying out with a loud voice. You just cannot think a prayer. We cannot be delivered without crying out with a loud voice, with tears and fear. It is impossible. If we are concerned enough to lift up our voice, we will get wisdom. Pr 2 teaches us how to ask for wisdom, how to actually arrive at fear, wisdom and understanding. It teaches us how to come to the knowledge of God.

We have to have these separate men's and women's meetings each time two people get married. We know from the teaching "Our Children" that our children's sex education is lifelong. Their best teachers are their own parents, as they observe how they are toward one another; the child observes the parent's whole behavior. We just cannot put off their sex education until right before they are married. We must be teaching *Joe's Body* with wisdom. Our children will learn their sexual feelings are normal. "My pituitary gland puts out hormones and I start feeling this way. It is preparing me for marriage." This way the evil one cannot come in and inject an evil spirit about their normal development.

Children in the world learn all wrong. It is always the older boy or the new kid on the block who teaches the younger children all about sex. This is how the homosexual spirit is passed on. It can happen here if we are not bonding with our children. We will need to be watchful in the situations where the parents are saved and their children are not. We do not want the bonding to take place with these other spirits. The Proverbs rightly taught will teach our children to recognize a fool and have nothing to do with him. Your child should know to come to you when a "fool" tells him something he did not learn from you. If the child does not have that freedom in his relationship with his parents — to come and talk to them — then they have *probably lost that child*.

One of our boys, when he was sixteen, went to Gabby's and saw a picture of a naked woman pinned up on the wall. He got an erection and did not even know how to masturbate. It was a good thing that he was so pure.

Andrew (on a waiting period with Lebanah) was asked not to come to this teaching so that the married men of Island Pond could teach him at their men's meeting. WE MUST HAVE THESE MEETINGS BEFORE PEOPLE GET MARRIED. We prayed and gave thanks.

Basic Things

This teaching is only the basic things we would tell a person who is ignorant of what to do on his honeymoon. Pr 12:4; 31:10-12 — She brings him good and not harm all the days of her life. Mt 19:4-6 — The teaching about vows, *For This Cause*, must be taught to everyone. There is no marriage without

coming out from under your parent's authority. This is what our Master said. They have no more influence over you. When you talk to them, it is just like talking to any other brother or sister.

Eph 5:31-33 — Paul said, “A husband is to love his wife as he loves himself, and she is to respect him.” Without your wife you are alone, not just sexually but in a much greater way. She encompasses him physically, mentally, socially, psychologically, and spiritually. In all these areas she is to complete him (Gen 2:18). A wife has a tremendous vocation to fulfill, but she cannot do it without the man bringing her alongside of him. The Holy Spirit is helpless unless we let Him come alongside of us. Eph 5:25 — The wife respects the husband because of the greater task he has. It is hard for the wife to give this respect if the husband is not giving up his life in this way.

Eze 16:8 — This is the entering of the marriage relationship. Ruth 3:9 speaks of the marriage covenant, the profound mystery. Gen 2:24 — Man and woman were created to become one flesh. It is a unity effected by God Himself so that a permanent union would result. (This is before Adam and Eve fell. The in-laws must be kept out of the marriage or it will end up in disaster.) This permanent union allowed a greater possibility of communion and happiness to come forth from that union and communion. Union and communion are not the same. You can be in union and not in communion with our Master or your wife. We have union in order that we might have communion.

“Flesh” in Hebrew represents the entire person. Marriage is not just body, it is life; the joining of life and soul. We become one flesh, yet each is still distinct. So, we are joined in sympathy, interest, and purpose. Husband and wife are no longer two but one flesh. She enters into all of these aspects of his life: spirit, soul, and body. She fulfills the loneliness in his spirit and soul — intellect, emotions, and will.

At the marriage the woman submits by kissing him; it is her initiative. Ps 2:12 — Kiss the Son. Now Judas betrayed Yahshua with the very act that denotes submission, “Why betray me with a kiss?” Yahshua asked him. Do not fail to share the VOWS TEACHING from “For This Cause, Part 2” at the same time. She became a suitable helper to him. Sexual union is not sexual communion. You can have sexual union without sexual communion. Look up the word *communion*. When you do not sing with all your heart you are not in communion, but only union. You must live Him with all your strength and heart. What we do not do with all our strength and heart is not from communion.

Sexual union without sexual communion is almost fornication (Heb 13:4). It is the first step toward defiling the marriage bed. You will let another spirit come into the marriage. It leads to fornication. You lose interest so your mind goes somewhere else. It is just getting the physical act over with, only a release; you might as well masturbate.

Mt 19:5-6 — Our Master recalls the original order of creation, which allowed no divorce except for fornication. (He agreed with what is written in Genesis. He quoted it, so do not let anyone start symbolizing the earliest things in the Bible.) In Israel marriage is for life. Mk 12:25 — We will not have angel nature but we will be like them in not marrying. This is the only day when our love can be expressed in genital pleasure. In the next age there will not be genital love for us. This is the only time to love your wife. We will not be married to our wives in the age to come. We will be man — not distinct male and female.

Hakam: How she completes you now is how you will be then. She is completed by completing you. Sex in marriage is the expression of one's being. How are you anyway? How does your wife see you? You are no better than your sex life. Sex in marriage testifies to the fact that man was created male and female (Gen 1:27) with natural, normal, healthy attraction between the sexes. Heb 13:4 — The marriage should be honored by all. If the marriage bed is not kept pure, you will not enter the Kingdom. The pure marriage bed, with the normal, healthy attraction of a man and a wife to one another, will in these last days be a witness against Sodom and Gomorrah.

We are the seed that is left. Rom 9:29 — A seed left over from planting. Heb 13:4 will be the ensign and standard that God made man male and female, distinct. Anyone who goes against Heb 13:4 will be cut off from Israel. He will judge you if you think about another woman during intercourse. Pr 5:18-19 — Remember how happy it was on your honeymoon? Well, it should increase. Pr 2:17 — Who did this? The Roman Church did.

The Honeymoon

Woman is created for man. No other creature can fulfill man. He made women differently. He made her of his rib so she would be submissive. Man is alone until she comes alongside and fulfills him in every area, or else they are both alone. Woman is the initiator of the fulfillment of man so that he is not alone. Let us make sure these things are communicated to the man before he is married:

- a. Make sure your fingernails are trimmed, filed round, smooth and short.
- b. Make sure you do not insert your penis until she is ready for it. You must learn to tell when she is ready. This is especially true for virgins, but applies as well to all of our wives. One way to tell is by the vulva — it swells up with blood. You must allow time for the muscles around the vagina to relax. This knowledge is not instinctive; we are not animals. Most pain experienced by women is from entering too quickly, especially for virgins.
- c. Make sure you do not strive to bring your wife to climax with your penis in her vagina. This is to virgins. You must understand each word, like *strive*. Be sensitive to her on the first night. If she is a virgin, she will be sore enough anyway.
- d. If you have a climax before her, what should you do? You can gently withdraw your penis and stimulate her with your hand. Many women have never experienced climax, maybe fifty percent, mainly due to the insensitivity of the husband. Usually your penis in her vagina will not alone stimulate her enough for climax. Our Father gave woman the clitoris for no other reason than her pleasure. Our Father designed it perfectly in the right place so that the man has to be sensitive. The man is supposed to have sensitivity and common sense. If the clitoris was in the canal you would not have to have communion to bring your wife to climax.
- e. Your tender care of your wife at this crucial time will establish a permanent mutual trust. It will enable her to totally relax in the future and let go with the enjoyment of your lovemaking. This time sets the tone for the rest of your married life.
- f. If you have difficulty inserting your penis it must be because her hymen is tight. Make sure you have plenty of lubrication, natural or otherwise (a good, *water-soluble*, organic lubricant). Men, but not all men, have a pre-ejaculate lubrication. This is a clear fluid that prepares the canal for semen. If this is not enough use a lubricant. Never use oil or petroleum products. Water-soluble glycerin is good. Adequate vaginal lubrication — hers, yours, or artificial — is absolutely essential for her pleasure during your intercourse. When she is lying on her back her lubrication flows with gravity. You must use your fingers to bring it down. Her vulva becomes full of blood, seemingly reaching out; now she is ready. The longer you have an erection before entering, the more pleasure you will have. What is desirable is that both of you would have emotional release. Sometimes the hymen is tough and resistant. The opening of a virgin's hymen is about one inch. So, with lubrication it must be stretched to allow entrance of the penis. Usually it will bleed. Newlyweds must know they can stretch the hymen with lubricated fingers or the penis for comfortable intercourse or they will experience frustration. Some women experience pain. "It hurts so good" — it hurts, but feels good at the same time. Some women want to go on; some don't. Our Father wants us to have pleasure in our sex. In some virgins the hymen is already broken. You can stretch the hymen with your fingers by pressing downward firmly toward the back, slowly, for ten or fifteen minutes. This is an emergency situation. This is for the husband to do. It slows them down and enforces intimacy and trust. There will be some bleeding. It is normal and expected. Do not rush to the hospital.

If the husband has too hard a time entering the vagina, let the wife lie on her back with two pillows under her hips, her legs as straight and flat as possible. With plenty of lubrication around the vagina, the husband should not force his penis in but gently insert it as the woman slowly raises her knees as may be necessary to alleviate discomfort.

The honeymoon is the time of coming together. It can be a disappointing time if the couple is unprepared or misinformed. We do not want that to happen. They must be rightly informed. We are just beginning. The

honeymoon sets the whole course for their married life. It is up to the parents and the Edah to set the proper patterns now instead of twenty years from now.

Don't set a goal for your honeymoon. Don't try to bring her to climax, especially on your first night. If you do this she will think she is supposed to respond and perform when she can not force her body. You may cause her to say she has had a climax when she hasn't. Climax happens in a relaxed atmosphere, and only when both are emotionally and physically aroused. There is communion of soul and life.

The feelings of pressure that come from the husband's expectations and her fear of failure can completely hinder the physical response she would otherwise have. She must be aroused emotionally and this seldom happens quickly. Take plenty of time and savor every moment. Enjoy the time; it is like supping. (There is no way you can have a relationship with Messiah except by supping with Him. We can only take in a small amount at a time. He wants just what is genuine in our heart. He doesn't expect a lot from us. We have to sip and sup with Him. Eating is not a proper translation in Rev 3:20.)

Don't be surprised on your honeymoon if you ejaculate before you want to. You are not a failure if this happens before your wife reaches a climax. It is normal. Don't be goal-oriented. Instead tenderly bring her to climax with plenty of lubrication on her clitoris.

The clitoris is too sensitive to be approached first. She must be fulfilled if she just can't climax with your penis. The clitoris is called the trigger of female desire. It is the most sensitive part of a woman for sexual arousal or pleasure. It has no other function. Sufficient physical stimulation of the clitoris alone will bring a woman to climax. The man must learn the exact location of the clitoris. Don't go there first during the time of sexual arousal. Wait until she is aroused before you stimulate the clitoris. Then place your well-lubricated fingers alongside the shaft of the clitoris, on both sides. Not yet on the head of the clitoris. The head is too sensitive at first. You will be able to feel it as you move your fingers back and forth and side to side. Be very sensitive and gentle. Persistent, gentle, loving, sensitive, and well-lubricated stimulation will bring almost any woman to climax. It is a very real problem; some women don't have sexual release. Man's impotence comes from the wife not enjoying sex. If your wife has climax without all of this, the more power to you.

Make sure she is prepared. After the honeymoon, when it doesn't hurt any longer, she will let you know when she is ready. Ideally we should never do it until she is ready, but in community we sometimes hurry before someone knocks on the door. We must eliminate the problem of children in our rooms. It is better for everyone to have privacy firmly established. Your children should knock on your door and wait for your answer. On family nights there should be no disturbance.

If your wife is on her period, you do not have sexual intercourse. It is possible at the beginning of her period to have intercourse accidentally, not realizing she is beginning her flow. This is what Lev 15:24 is talking about — you are unclean for seven days. But, if you knowingly have intercourse before a full seven days have passed, you are cut off from Israel (Lev 20:18). Our Father wants the woman to be clean before intercourse. Seven full days are required. Come back together on the eighth day.

Make sure the vagina is very lubricated before you put your penis in. Get an organic, water-soluble, good lubricant for honeymooners. The longer you have an erection before you insert your penis in her vagina, the more enjoyment you will experience. There is more emotional release. Sometimes you have an afterglow, sometimes you don't. A woman has an afterglow after climax — a nice, warm, comfortable feeling. Have a nice, warm, wet cloth so you don't have to go to the bathroom immediately. You don't want semen all over the bed so none of the world's diseases can come upon us (Lev 15).

Anal intercourse is absolutely forbidden and if you depend on oral sex your brain will prevent you from getting an erection any other way. It is a wrong foundation. You can't find it forbidden in the Bible, but it doesn't build up. It is better to stimulate the one you love the way we are speaking of here. This is the more excellent way.

Be sensitive to your wife. Some take longer to come to climax than others. Newlyweds must be taught that when you are stimulating along the clitoral shaft your tempo must increase as she approaches climax. When the clitoris is first stimulated in foreplay, very light, gentle, slow caressing usually gives the most pleasure and satisfaction. Be careful not to irritate; in just a few seconds it can become too sensitive. If it gets too sensitive, then go further up the side of the shaft, gently and lovingly to give her more pleasure. Don't concentrate on this

part first. Kiss her, caress her breasts, thighs, neck, whatever *she* enjoys. SEX IS GOOD, not evil.

Honeymoon Cystitis

The urethra is the outlet for the urine above the bladder. It is just below the clitoris, about half an inch above the vagina. It is entirely separate from the vagina. On the honeymoon there can be a bruising of the urethra, commonly called “honeymoon cystitis.” It is a pain in the bladder area caused by blood and urine. There is severe burning when she urinates. It is an indication that injury to the urethra has allowed bacteria to grow. This bacteria may go up or ascend and cause a bladder infection, which is called cystitis. The infection will clear up more quickly if she increase her fluid intake. This will purify her system. (Anyone who does not drink water is crazy.) Some medications may have to be used. Lubrication may prevent her getting cystitis as it limits friction and bruising. Lubrication is absolutely essential the first few weeks as well as knowing how to act gently and sensitively. Know where the clitoris is. Help prevent your bride from getting the painful condition of urethra cystitis. This usually occurs in the first couple of weeks of intercourse. It is a urinary tract infection that mostly occurs within the first forty-eight hours after initial intercourse.

Most cases of failure to experience orgasm can be ascribed to poor preparation for marriage. A frustrating and fearful honeymoon followed by a period of disappointment, blundering, and boredom. All of these conditions the wife to think there is no hope of fulfillment. She feels like a failure. She needs that release to be bonded to you. If the husband feels she is not interested he could become impotent. He can bring her to fulfillment by either his penis or his hand. By giving her this enjoyment he can make her whole and healthy. Men want to know that she enjoys it. Every woman should have sexual climax. It is healthy for you and for her.

You cannot live on just the physical sex act if you are truly married. Men easily come to climax, so it is good that they use patience to bring her to climax. The penis does not come into direct contact with the clitoris during sexual intercourse. The missionary style is not the only position. Doctors say it is better to come from behind if you want to get pregnant. Try different ways. Be a good lover. Penis size does not matter.

1 Cor 7:3-5 — Both the man and the woman have a right for sexual fulfillment. Don't be a blundering fool, demanding your rights. Let a man demonstrate his love for his wife by how he approaches her, not by claiming his rights. A husband must be careful not to appear hurried, crude, rude, mechanical, or impatient. Sexual intercourse should be a joyful affirmation of two people's love life together. It either draws them together or drives them apart because your sexual relationship will reflect your emotional love for one another. Every meaningful sexual encounter begins with a loving, attentive attitude hours or days before. The wife views the sexual act as part of her relationship with you. Your relationship is your daily behavior toward each other. Do not harbor anger or it will corrode into resentment or bitterness; it adds untold problems to your marriage. Don't ever, *ever*, let the sun go down on your anger.

If we don't have meetings with the bride and the groom before their wedding, their blood is on our hands. What will happen if you don't love your wife as Messiah loved the Church? You will see death. We may as well take a vow because we really already have. A yes is a yes. Our relationship must be perfect.

Comments:

Yonah: My whole life passed before me, the neighborhood boys, etc. At low times in my life, times of duress, I have not been able to get an erection and I have felt lower than a dog because of my expectations. In those times my wife has really supported me because she did not have those expectations. The realm of sex in the world is rivalry. The whole locker room mentality is so competitive and strife-filled. It makes a man worthless. I remember the anxiety of wondering whether my penis was big enough to satisfy a woman — a concept totally devoid of communication or love. I thought it was like the act of any beast. We can't communicate what we have heard today to virgins unless they are in us. We have to have a proper respect for women.

There are times possibly when we won't be able to get an erection because of what is going on in us. We are spiritual beings, sexual arousal is not just a glandular thing. Sometimes we can't even express what is going on in us. We can't have a false sense of accomplishment in our sexuality or we will be devastated when in our low times we are unable to have an erection. I don't want anything of the world in me. We can't go back to being

virgins. We are the stem. I'm thankful our children will have a bonding with their spouse that will last. Men and women are not rivals anymore.

Only a perverted woman thinks about penis size. It is not how big you are. Your wife enjoys *you*, not your penis. Her biggest sex organ is her brain. A normal, average penis size is five inches long.

Kharash: Out of the realm of the relationship of one person to another you compare and look at externals.

It is hell out there.

Lev: That bonding must happen between men and women. If you don't bond with your wife she can ruin you. She has the power to make a man or a mouse out of him by the way she communicates. He can either overcome everything that comes his way or else be overcome by anything according to how she builds him up or tears him down.

Every wife should be given opportunity to experience release. When a man realizes his wife is not being satisfied and he tries to please her more and in other ways, she views his attempts as vulgar and distasteful. She becomes silent, sullen, and indifferent. She has learned wrong to be this way toward his advances. The result is that the man is passive and impotent or else he goes and looks elsewhere for satisfaction.

Yonah: Adultery begins with not finding social and physical with your wife so you look elsewhere.

Hakam: It was really important what we said about compatibility. There was an area of my life where my wife did not feel adequate to help me. I encouraged her and she really blossomed far beyond my expectations. We must teach our children the things that we hear. The fruit is good.

Lo-Nekar: I never had a father who spoke to me like this. I have wondered, "Is it possible I can be washed of all these things in me? Is it possible or is it too late?" It is possible because we are hearing it now. We want to have a new mind so we can pass it on.

If you don't pass it on you don't appropriate it for yourself either.

Oseh Shalom: We can bring about a generation of undefiled marriages. My wife changed my view of all women. Our Father restores man through his wife. She helps him socially.

Kharash: Things went deep today. We are being delivered from Christianity. We can only save our children if this word saves us. If it is words of salvation we will pass it on to our children.

A few weeks ago our Father spoke to us about the women's paper. The women were crying in their burden. Wherever Paul went he related his testimony. We must give our testimony like Paul did.

Gader: I'm sick of my notebooks. I'm sick of things just sitting untouched in my notebooks. This has got to come out of our notebooks and into our life.
