Polished Arrow, Part 1

A polished arrow gets to the heart of the matter — polished for speed and accuracy — a secret weapon, hidden — the word which goes right to the place where that person is at, where their heart is. The word will not come back void without accomplishing the purpose it was intended for. The word makes it clear whether they are drawn to our Master or not.

What is tantamount to the loss of the Spirit? What is most obvious, what speaks of the loss of the Spirit? The loss of what, is tantamount to the loss of the Spirit? How do you know you have been sealed with the Spirit?

Blank is tantamount to the loss of the Spirit? The loss of ______ is tantamount to the loss of the Spirit. Is the loss of joy tantamount to the loss of the Spirit? What is the word that describes the equivalent value of having the Spirit? How do we know we are sealed with the Spirit? Can we lose love? Is the loss of love tantamount to the loss of the Spirit? What kind of love can we lose? We are to love each other with fervent, ahavah love, with a sacrificial love like our Master. Love is fervent love. What if you lose your fervent love? Who can lose the Spirit? Did the Corinthians lose the Spirit? Did the Ephesians lose the Spirit? Yes, they lost the Spirit. Eph 6:24 — says undying love, so it means that love can die. What happens if you don't have an undying love? What did He say to the Corinthians? Cursed — cut off (1 Cor 16:22).

Love can die. If love dies, how do you keep your undying love? Can we lose the Spirit? We mean, that we are filled with the Spirit. If we are filled with the Spirit, we are filled with love. So not having love is like not having the Spirit. If we are not filled then, there is some flesh.

The true Edah died off in the first church (like Laodicea) because of their sin — they cut themselves off because they didn't pass on the Holy Spirit to others, so they transferred to just form (which is Christianity today). It is a process of dullness, a lack of sharpness. It is a transformation, being unable to discern the angel of light. 1 Jn 3:6 — Drifting is an unconscious process.

An undying love loves Yahshua, as He said, "If you love Me, you will obey Me." The church can die. It can be cut off.

How do you know you have a fervent love? For each other? Would you say you had fervent love for your brothers and sisters? What about Jn 8:51? Where would you be if you died? How do you know if you have a fervent love for your brothers (1 Pet 1:22)? What if you don't have this fervent love? Why did Peter have to write them a letter?

Do we have a fervent (look up the definition) love for the least of the brethren? Leaders are to lead with zeal. If they don't and die, they go to death. Leaders should now pray not to die if we have yet to love with this fervent love. We can only go up right now. He loves us; we are blessed to have the word. If we pray for Him to speak to us, He will, if we don't have a condemned conscience.

Yahshua had to learn obedience — that is an amazing thing. Fervent love — our Master said, "You do not have because you do not ask." Knock so the one on the other side of the door hears you and knows you mean business.

Christianity makes you dull to the word because it has no place, no work there. We must make every moment here in Germany count because we have been sent here at great cost.
