Enduring Spirit

Those who have the enduring spirit will make it to the end. The breath of life must continue to be in us. We must be faithful. We must keep our first love or we will fall away like the Ephesian church. Your spirit is everywhere your cells are. Your spirit goes everywhere your breath goes. Your spirit needs to fill every cell of your body. If your spirit leaves, your body dies.

We must remember our Creator in the days of our youth. Those who are led by the Spirit are the children of God. We must make sure that we are His children. If we make sure we are led by the Spirit... A lot of sin comes from how we treat one another. We are extensions of Messiah. If you mistreat one person, you are mistreating all. You are spitting on God when you spit on the sidewalk, because it is a law set up by people in His image.

We need to treat each other as brothers of the body of Messiah. All law is based on how we regard one another.

Woman's desire must be for man, and she must submit to man (her husband). She must endure the pains of childbirth. Man must work by the sweat of his brow. This is the second covenant.

We are a collective Messiah. We will rule with Him if we endure till the end. We must build endurance. We must have the mind of Messiah so that our life would be a light.

Our God said surely they'll obey since I've given them my Holy Spirit. Even so, the first church fell away. You love Messiah by the way you hear and obey (Mark 4). Everyone hears differently because they love differently. All men will know we are His disciples because of how we love one another. We are to love one another as He loved us. In that the world will know the Father sent the Son.

Our accumulated suffering in the body must make up for Messiah's suffering (Col 1:24). If you endure pain, you will reign with Him.

Because we pray, our Father can use us — that's how we love one another — through ministering our giftings.

Romans 8 — Those who are led by the Spirit are the children of God. Messiah reconciled us to the Father. The Son came to reconcile us to the Father. The Spirit wants us to know the Son. Continual differing? We do not keep the glory for ourselves.

Our Father draws people to Him like a magnet -- it is hard to resist. You don't ever have to doubt because you were drawn. It's the Father who drew you. Father means the source of everything. We've come back to the Source.

Your talent is not your ability; talent is grace. Grace is used to employ your abilities. You have to use all of your grace. You must use all of your talents, even if you just have one. People who don't use their one talent are worthless and will be cast out. We will go to death if we don't use all the grace that's in us.

To be a disciple you must die to yourself. You must consider the flesh dead every day or you'll be led by it. If you are led by the Spirit you will have life and peace.

We have the word to bring us back into the reality of being baptized into the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. The path of the righteous is like the rising of the sun. Just a little bit, then more and more, then you see the light of the sun, then you see the sun.

Every day you go back to baptism, keeping the flesh dead. When you say, "It's what I want to do, it's what is in my heart," then that's repentance (Jn 15:8). We abide in the vine by living by the Spirit. We must walk in our names, the reality of who we are. This is how we act.

There is a *real* attraction to your brothers. "How can you love what is unseen before you love what is seen?" Loving as our Master loved is taking on the suffering which comes to you, taking on those sufferings so that your brother's life is better. We exist by what we hear. We must shout from the rooftops what is whispered in our ear. We are pruned by the word.
