## A Seed Preserved

In view of Rom 9:29, we read an article about what is going on in the Christian Church today. Rom 9:29 in the Greek version reads, "Isaiah said if the Sovereign of Hosts had not left us a seed as Sodom we would have become and Gomorrah we should have been made like." This cannot be talking about anyone but us. It's obvious. Paul knew the church would fall.
