

Unworthy of Messiah — Matthew 10:37

We can lift up our hands because we have not offended anyone with our hands — our hands represent our heart. We are thankful for hope. Before we had no hope. Faith, hope and love will go on forever.

[re: Alessandra wants to come back. (She was named Bachirah.) She severed herself from Messiah and left us for a man. We don't know whether or not she received the Holy Spirit. She got pregnant but she lost the baby and her boyfriend.]

So now we have to judge. If she *had* gotten married, etc., would she have come back? Decisions are made this way — what seems good to us and to the Holy Spirit. We have to take that as our Father speaking to us.

People feel like she should not leave her son up there since there is no legal thing holding him back, only *her* mother. (Now if it becomes a legal thing with her son and she would not leave him for Messiah, she would not be worthy of Messiah, based on Mt 10:37; Mk 10:29; Lk 14:26. Read those three so that we can understand what it says about this.) They have to leave their children if they *have to*. They should bring them if they can, but if they cannot, they should follow YAHSHUA regardless. But in this case we feel that she can bring Him regardless of her mother — because she is to follow YAHSHUA regardless of her mother.

Emet — a person who truly wants to have a king in their lives would let go of everything and if he has something that is his, he would bring it to the Body and if it is a son, then that son would be blessed in the Body.

Ok, so we agree that she should bring the child. In case the man who has legal authority wants the child, then she will have to come without the child.
