

No Excuse

1 Cor 2:7-11 — He revealed these things which God has prepared for those who love Him. He reveals to us even the profound things of God, even what is beyond man's ability to understand. So you see in v.11, that the spirit of man and the Spirit of God are compatible, they are made for one another. The spirit of man is made for the Spirit of God. So man has no excuse because God's Spirit knows what is in a man. And now we have the Holy Spirit *in* our spirit — we have *no* excuse. We don't have to be deceived if we don't want to be deceived. The only way we can be deceived is if we want to be. Jms 1:14 — Don't say you are being tempted. Because each one is led away and enticed by his own evil desires within him. Thus the enemy works along *with* us and the Holy Spirit, also, works along with us. And we give ourselves to whatever spirit we choose. We have the choice. Yahshua already died on the cross and released mankind from Satan's hold, so now we can choose to be liberated from it; we can choose which spirit to give ourselves to. Satan comes in and entices us, and the Holy Spirit comes and entices us. It is up to us what spirit we want to be brought along by — it is our choice. We have a choice. We have no excuse. A man is drawn away, baited by his own evil desire. What is in us? You can judge yourself every morning. You know what is working in you — you have no excuse whatsoever. You can choose to give yourself over to Yahshua for the sake of the gospel. So no one has an excuse. Even the people in the world have no excuse (Rom 1:20), so how much less of an excuse do we have. But some people hang Him up to public shame (Heb 6:6) when they fall away from Him. But you can't blame Satan or God — blame yourself — you have the blame directly upon you because it is not beyond your power to do something about it. Whatever we get, we deserve. Our destiny is what we deserve. God is just. We bring judgment on ourselves if we allow ourselves to be led away by our evil desire. Don't blame it on Satan, blame it on yourself. It is the evil desires working within yourself.
