Vitally Connected

We have to be vitally connected to the vine and bear much fruit — come to fruition. If we do not come to fruition, producing the expected fruit, we will go to judgment as those who were not connected to Him. If we did not bear much fruit and prove to be His disciples, are we disciples?

The reason our Father does not hear our prayers sometimes is because of one person who is out of fellowship and we are not extending grace to them. One person here in ritual voids the whole sacrifice. If our heart and desire is not to know Him, then we are not in fellowship, we are not in communion. The Holy Spirit can be with a person but not *in* him until he surrenders and is immersed into Messiah. Then the Holy Spirit enters into him and he is sealed with Him. He might be *with* a person, leading him, but after a person is sealed with the Holy Spirit, he can have grace upon him and have His power upon him (Jn 14:17).

Before the race starts, all doubt will be erased about ourselves. People will have opportunity to express that doubt and go into the water and erase that doubt. Anytime up to that time — any day is a good time. I would rather make sure than to ever be plagued with *any* doubt.

Then after that we have the assurance to go to the throne of grace with boldness and confidence, boldness and confidence that we did not have before, if we have not been *sealed* until the day of redemption.
