

All Creation is Waiting

Paul was very expressive. In fact he said all creation is waiting for the sons of God to be revealed. All creation. He's not talking about just little streams of water waiting, he's talking about galaxies, he's talking about planets, all creation waiting eagerly, expecting the sons of God to be revealed upon the universe. All creation! It doesn't just say the earth. *All creation is waiting.* So the sons of God are very significant people. And we have to judge ourselves right, discern His Body.

Years ago we learned what *tantamount* was. The loss of love is *tantamount* to the loss of the spirit. That means it's the same thing — no love, no spirit.

Our Father knows who we are. We don't even know who we are. It's hidden from us most of the time. The revelation is hidden from us. We walk around with a little bit of light. Most of the time we walk around in darkness — we don't even know who we are. We wonder why all this trouble we're going through; why does it have to be this way? We need the spoken word. We need prophets. Back in the Old Testament Reuben didn't have any prophets. Reuben didn't have anything. Reuben has to be restored. Reuben has to go beyond where they were in the Old Testament. They have to be saved in this age. There have to be prophets raised up here, evangelists, teachers, shepherds — all the gifts, but especially that you would prophesy, open up the understanding of our hearts to know really who we are.

When we drink the victory cup without judging ourselves right, we go into the breaking of bread unworthy, not in a worthy manner, not in a corresponding way as He walked. It's tantamount, Paul says, to murdering Messiah! Read it! We're guilty of the blood of Messiah. Paul really wrote that. The Holy Spirit was really upon him. He wants us to know how important we are, that we would not walk into the breaking of bread without even confessing our sins, without carrying out an inspection of ourselves, an examination, that we would not walk right in and murder Messiah! Read it — 1 Cor 11:27 — murdering Messiah, guilty of His blood, guilty of the blood of the world's sin.

We have to come to understanding. He wants us to know who we are, not walking around in darkness, not knowing where we're going. He wants us to come to understanding. Who do you think you are to be unkind to your wife, to your brother? Who do you think you are? You don't have any right to do that. We are to *crucify our flesh*. That's what the breaking of bread means and requires.

Just think about Sardis. In Rev 3:4 it says that most of them had stained their garments. Most of them were defiled, but they went on into the breaking of bread anyway, and most of them died. Only a few overcame. They weren't discerning the Body. They weren't saying, "Father, give me discernment! I need wisdom. I need understanding. I need grace. I can't be one of your sons without what you give me to be your son."

We don't understand. We need understanding. We can be so stupid sometimes. Have you ever thought about *knowing* Him? Our Master wants us to be intimately acquainted with Him, and have the right fear. We need to discern the Body, really know who we are, sons of God. The whole creation is waiting for the sons of God to be revealed. It says that the sons of God are going to rule the universe for God. God is not going to rule without His manifestation in human nature. God created us to rule. He wants to rule through humanity. We are very important, chosen above all the people on the earth. To love Him is to love our brothers and sisters more than our own life. He's waiting. What is He waiting on me for? To rule over my own flesh!

Somebody said that in the first church they did all these signs and wonders, called fire down from heaven, drew great crowds... Who's going to give great signs and wonders? We can't even love our brothers!!! Maybe when we start loving our brothers He will do it. We're being restored. We don't even know who we are. So maybe our Father has that in mind. But He's certainly not going to put His power in the hands of foolish men.

We've got to start in the morning and put Him on and keep on walking. When the enemy comes, "It's in the name of Yahshua I rebuke you, evil one." Have you ever done that? Every once in a while you've *got to do it* or you get so burdened down that you'll have to be cleansed. You *have to* if you want to *live!* You have to, in the name of our Master YAHSHUA, not in your own power. You have to go to the throne of grace.

That's just a little bit about being a son of God. How big is the universe? How big is a galaxy? Well, it takes billions of years to go through them. And how many galaxies are there? Well, that's what He wants us to rule over — generations and generations, forever and ever (Eph 3:21).
