

We Need to Know Who We Are

We are really the most privileged generation that has ever lived. There is nothing to be compared with our calling. Our Father regards us above all other people that ever lived. He called us to bring in the kingdom. It hasn't dawned on us how we have been chosen in this age to be the scions, people that have been chosen in one age to live into the next. We don't really understand that.

Dan 2:44; 2:35 speaks about a kingdom in one age that goes into another age. Mt 13:31-33 — Our Master spoke about this here. A tree, also leaven that goes over. He caused us to be born in this age to bring about the age to come.

Dan 2:35 — The stone that struck the statue *became* a great mountain and filled the whole earth. His very character and life is going to be like a high mountain; a high place that will fill the whole earth. Verse 44 talks about a people. That's us. It won't be left to another people.

Abraham was a scion. He came out of Ur into Israel. It is like coming out of one age into another. He created Israel. We are creating another Israel that will go over into another age and rule the whole world and of course in the eternal age over all.

Just like our Master, we can't do anything unless we have revelation and understanding of who we are. Our Father confirmed our Master through everything that He read and heard about Himself, what He thought about Himself, when the dove came upon him. After that he was ready to go into the wilderness and face Satan's temptation and overcome him. There will be a people who overcome Satan.

Rev 12:11 is going to be the characteristic of these people and they pass it on to their children who become the Male Child. We kneed to know who we are. It has to be revealed to us. Just like it was to our Master. I don't know exactly what Mary told Him and what kind of understanding He had from her. When He was a baby he didn't know who He was. When He was a boy He said, "I have to do my Father's business." When He was 30 years old He began His ministry.

Our Father didn't choose the Bruderhof and the Mennonites. You can see how scattered they are and divided. The Bruderhof didn't develop into the twelve tribes. They cannot possibly be the formation of the Stone Kingdom. Our Father gave us the concept of Israel. Israel cannot be Israel except there are twelve tribes. Rev 7 — There are twelve tribes at the end of the New Testament age. We regard ourselves as that formation that comes about. We have high regard. We regard ourselves as the people of God. That's a great boast (Heb 3:6). The house of God is twelve tribes, that is His dwelling place. The first church had the boast but they didn't keep it until the end.

Mal 1:5; Isa 49:6 — There will be many dwelling places outside the natural borders of Israel. Anyone who has the understanding of Paul of Isa 49:6 and bring it about are the people of God.

Jn 14:21 — When we speak of revelation many of us don't get it. We don't know who we are. Not that we think too highly about ourselves.

Was our Master special? Israel is a peculiar people, that's what it says but it actually means special. Israel is set apart, a special people. He wants a people to know that they won't die before the new age comes — "when you see the new shoots of the fig tree" — that generation won't pass away until all these things that He spoke of on the discourse on the Mount of Olives will take place.

Our Father spoke to me about this years ago. I took hope and courage. It needs to come into a people. Our Master wanted us to be encouraged, have heart that we won't die. Some of us will die. They will be martyrs (Rev 19:2-3).

A person who is martyred is blessed above all people. It's according to our Father's purpose. Would you want to be a martyr? Our Father wants us to talk about it to our children. It has to go into them because it's going to happen. If we don't talk about it, it will take us by surprise.

The dead in Messiah will be raised first when our Master comes back and they will be part of that army that marches across the heavens.

Mt 24:32-35 — Look up the word *regard*. They regarded themselves as the house of God (Heb 3:6). No one shall regard themselves as the house of God unless they are twelve tribes. That's how it's going

to be in this age, the next age, and the age to come.

The wife of the Lamb, the wife that's worthy of the Lamb is twelve tribes.

Rev 21:9,12,2,3 — Always put these verses together.

The wife is twelve tribes. It removes all that symbolism about a wife, some type of thing of going to heaven. It's actually going to be twelve tribes in the universe. There must be something going on that hasn't been revealed to us yet.

The only time anyone can be humble is if they know who they really are. Then there is no threat. Authority isn't threatened unless it's your own made-up authority. You have to realize who you are in order to be humble.

Our Master knew who He was. We have to have the same attitude that He had.
