Repulsive

To be repulsed by any brother or sister just because of the way he, because you don't like to be around him long, or talk to him, or be caught in a situation where you may have to spend time with him, is sin. It is sin that separates and negates unity and oneness in the Spirit.

Repulsed — To think of your brother or sister as repugnant. It is to think of him as distasteful. It is unpleasant for you to be stuck alone with him for over two minutes or you get a sickening feeling.

This is all the workings of the evil one against you. It is not against the person that is repulsive to you. He may be first in the Kingdom and you last. That is just because you allowed the enemy to deceive you into thinking that your brother or sister for whom Messiah died, and who is a sharer of the Holy Spirit with you, is repulsive to you. Actually, having fellowship and associating with him is the way by which you are prepared for Messiah. Eph 4:2-3 — Forbear with those who are of different temperaments. Associate with the lowly and the weaker (Rom 12:16-17; 1 Cor 12:22-25; Eph 4:2-3). This not only builds up the Body, making you a worker along with Messiah (Mt 12:30), but it is also for your personal up-building. Without giving yourself to this you fail as a disciple.
