## The Sacrifice of the Lawless

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination, how much more when he brings it with evil intent! (Proverbs 21:27)

The sacrifice of the lawless is detestable to God. The wicked are described in Rev 3:4; Heb 6:6; and 10:26. If those who are stained as in Rev 3:4, and those who are as 2 Tim 2:26, or Heb 6:6, or 10:26, yet they go on sinning (Jms 4:17), and continue to give a sacrifice of Rom 12:1 in pretense, not as Rom 12:2, or in any way as Col 1:10-11 or Eph 5:18-21, then it is like Pr 21:27 says — they are pretenders (Ps 116:13,17-19). Pr 21:27 says the sacrifice of the wicked (lawless) is an abomination, as Christianity, but worse, especially

Pr 21:27 says the sacrifice of the wicked (lawless) is an abomination, as Christianity, but worse, especially when they know better. As it says, how much more when they bring it, when they know they are not filled with the Spirit, or filled with thanksgiving, and give before all (Pr 21:28-29).

The All-Seeing Eyes of YHWH

1 Jn 3:22 – It is in His sight that we do evil or good. 1 Jn 3:4 – We either do lawless deeds or lawful deeds in the sight of Yahweh. We are talking about the all-seeing eyes of Yahweh. This is more what Pr 21:27 means, especially for those who are sinning in His sight, but are not fearful. They are not wise, but wicked. They are without fear of God. They are fools.

Phil 2:2-4 – Selfishness is going to the sacrifice in disobedience to Phil 2:2-4, or 1 Jn 3:16-17. Or it is going as 1 Jn 1:6 or 2:4 — when you know it. 1 Cor 11:27-29 – Not judging yourself right brings judgment upon you. A selfish person thinks more highly of himself than of others. This is a sin in the Body. It is the sin of not loving, not caring. One has to be deceptive to not care for others more than himself (Phil 2:3). We are to have the attitude in ourselves Messiah had (verse 5). If one is not obedient to verse 5, it is sin.
