In all our publications we must remember that we are writing for our Father (God) Himself (Jn 6:44), inspired by His Spirit, with His wisdom. His wisdom is that we should write on a sixth grade level, for *little children* (Lk 10:21-22).

Sixth grade level — when a person turns to age 12, the age of accountability.

If we write for any other reason than to be understood by little children, we ourselves have not become like *little children*. Mt 18:3 — It is *little children* to *little children*.

Jn 7:17 — Do you think that the wise and the learned are willing to do the will of the Father? To whom does the Son choose to reveal the Father? The proudly wise and learned? Or is it to those who are willing, have a willing spirit, to do His will (if only they could know what it is)?

Sixth Grade Level

This is the middle ground between first grade and twelfth grade (between the grades six and seven is the exact middle). Look at a sixth or seventh grade book and compare the language they use to how we write. If a college graduate cannot be reached by a sixth or seventh grade level article, then he is too high to receive from a *little child*. He is the wise and learned.

Our Master is trying to tell us something that a *little child* told us ten years or so ago. We must now hear!!! We cannot try to reach the high and lofty people who are wise and learned, for they usually are seeking their own glory and honor. *Little children* are not. They are simple and have to be told what to do, what to believe, what to say, and where to go, etc. They do not have a high and lofty mind (out of reach from Mk 9:37).

Mk 10:14-15.

The *little child*-like person is more receptive, more open to hear — and faith comes by hearing, receiving the person sent to them. The Kingdom of heaven must be received as a gift. It cannot be achieved by human effort as the world's mind has been taught. The kingdom of heaven may only be entered by *little child*-like people who know that they are helpless to do anything on their own, as Jn 15:5 speaks to *little children*.

Mk 9:37 — The high and lofty minded people will not receive *little child*-like person.

(And still remember to put a glossary in the back!)

Glossary means a list of items peculiar to a field of knowledge with explanations which enlighten, give light and understanding to what the reader does not know by reading a word or term foreign to his vocabulary. Otherwise, he simply glosses over and remains in his ignorance and lack of understanding. No fault can be laid upon us. Acts 20:26.

Explanation — illustrate, as you would explain to a child. And we must be like *little children* ourselves or the good news through us will be made void, like the message we, the *little children*, were waiting to hear (since we grew up hearing the message through the high and lofty).
