

grace (as all in Acts 4:33 were noted as *having*) are dangerous elements in the Body and must be closely watched and monitored by the astute leaders who watch over their soul as well as the souls they can *corrupt* (Heb 13:17). Even though all the elders have come out of the rock and roll generation and or country, jazz, bop and blues they must "see to it" and "guard the flock." The Elders should then be **even more astute** (perceptive) since they have come through the *transition* (Lk 13:24). Ethan, there is so much which should be *discussed* in view of this teaching. Please "see to it" amongst your leaders, along with those musicians who are personally involved in leading the Body in worship and praise to our Elohim. I am so thankful our Father is giving us wisdom and vision, leading us away from all the defilement of flesh and mind we once indulged in (Eph 2:1-3). Some of us have known nothing other than high and low class music. It's so good that our new life in Messiah also includes a "new reference point" which comes from having David's heart — *playing and singing sanctified music upon the instruments of God*.

Yoneq said "tell Ethan to speak up or die." You have every right to say what you feel and it should be heard. You are ETHAN. A priest of God who leads Israel in music and worship to YHWH. You are *responsible* for the direction of music in the Body just as much, if not more so, than most people.

A leader is only a good leader if he is *diligent*. That is what you expressed in your letter to Yoneq. You are a guard in His temple. You are perceptive to the Spirit's presence in our music. You have a voice. Use It! We have all been perverted by the world and music is by far, no exception. Our Father is purifying us along with our music (Jms 1:21). Whatever *filthiness* or *wickedness* remains in us from the world (even musically) must be put aside or we'll never be restored. We need to receive the word (*of the prophets*) implanted in us which is able to save our SOULS from death.

The anointing teaches us *everything* we need to know. I'm so thankful for the anointing in the Embodiment of Messiah. Now we can make a "new sound" with *purified lips* which praise Him *alone* for **He** is our song and our praise.
