

The Three Eternal Destinies #15 *What Determines Eternal Life and Eternal Death?(and the Three Prepared Places)*

There is much to the gospel. This is the gospel. This is what people need to understand and know. God determines eternal life or eternal death based on the conscience, for people who have never heard the good news.

Once they hear the good news and they reject it, they're judged already. Just like Rev 19:2-3 is Christianity being judged into that Lake of Fire, whatever that is, where the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever. This is not the eternal age. It begins in **this** same age, after they are burnt up with fire in Rev 18:8,10, and then it goes on into the second death. The next thing you see they go right into the Lake of Fire in **this** age. This is when the saints who have already gone on before us are in heaven rejoicing and this is before they come back down to earth (1 Ths 4:14-18).

The people who claimed to see go into the eternal death (Jn 9:39-41). They claimed to be forgiven and they claimed to know God, and persecuted and murdered the saints. He's another Jesus, a demon (2 Cor 11:2-4). They study another god, *Theos*, theology. They don't understand the spiritual nature of the last 1900 years. They just don't understand! So we have to let them understand the deluding influence and power that they are under. We were almost under it at one time, when we were set free and liberated into the restoration of all things.

You see in Mt 25:32-40 the good, who keep on doing good. Look how much good they did. They helped people, they clothed them, they visited them in prison, gave them food and drink. They just kept on. You can see that's just what they wanted to do, at the expense of their own life, they cared for the seed of Abraham. They will be blessed. Other people will be cursed because they didn't care for the seed of Abraham, the brothers of our Master. These blessed ones were taking care of our Master's brothers. So you can see that these people were in a different category than Yahshua's brothers. The people who helped them **weren't** Yahshua's brothers. They helped Yahshua's brothers. These people were the righteous of the nations, who helped *Yahshua's brothers*. And ***Yahshua's brothers were the seed of Abraham, in Gen 12:3. If you bless them you'll be blessed. If you curse them, you'll be cursed.*** The other people cursed them. "When did we see You?" He'll say, "When you didn't do it for the least of My brothers you didn't do it for Me. Depart from Me." They have a goat-like nature. The other people were sheep-like. Sheep-like people have to have a shepherd. **Their shepherd is their conscience** and they were led by their conscience to be that way. Otherwise they'll just continue to be evil. They never can repent.

Three Eternal Destinies

How many eternal destinies are there for mankind? Two? Heaven and Hell? Three! That's right. It's the Holy City (the New Jerusalem, the Twelve Tribes of Israel). That's the one destination for the redeemed of Yahweh. The other destination is the *Nations* and the third destination is the *Lake of Fire*, the second death — three eternal destinies. Mt 25:34 — It was prepared for the nations, the good people of the nations, the eternal nations. And the Lake of Fire is prepared for Satan and his angels and all those who were wicked. Then the Holy, a city was prepared for them. Heb 11:16 — That's the Holy City. The Holy City, the Nations, and the Second Death which is the Lake of Fire.

We're going to write a booklet on "The Three Eternal Destinies of Man," *prepared* for them. Prepared means : *befitting* for them; just recompense; what they are deserving or worthy of.

Nun: Gen 18:25 — Yoneq was talking to me yesterday about how our Father came and was speaking to Abraham. Abraham said, will you indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked? He was talking about Sodom because his nephew Lot was there. You can see that designation — even in the nations there are the righteous and the wicked. Then he went on to say, suppose there are 50 righteous in the city, will you indeed sweep it away and not spare the place for the sake of the 50 righteous who are in it? Verse 25 — It says an amazing thing. **"Far be it from You to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are treated alike!"** That is so clear. It totally exposes the gospel of Christianity. It's so heretical because our God is such a fair and

righteous God and He will not show that kind of judgment without discrimination between the sheep-like and the goat-like people who are in the nations. He will not treat them alike. **"Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?"** It was in reference to what He was saying, surely you will not treat the righteous and the wicked alike.

Obviously, Abraham had revelation of God's character that He was a just God, that there are those in the nations who are sheep. It says in Mt 25 that the sheep that have lived by that conscience. He's preserved a conscience in them. They're sheep. Sheep like to be led. They follow their conscience like sheep do a shepherd. Sheep follow! The goats, they don't need anyone to lead them. They butt up against one another. They're totally independent. It's in their nature. Our Master understood that. That's why He spoke about it here in Mt 25. He used those two animals here and their nature to illustrate what the two types of people there are in the nations, what they are like.

Those who lived by their conscience are preserved from that place prepared for the evil one. They've been preserved from that place because they have the conscience. Those are the ones who will inherit the kingdom. It's real obvious because He says, all the nations will be gathered before Him. All the people in the nations, both wicked and righteous. He said to the sheep, who are on His right, (the right hand denotes favor; the one whom He blesses), "Come, inherit the kingdom which has been prepared before the foundations of the earth for you." So He's prepared a place for them. They were guided by their conscience. They loved it. Then He describes their characteristics. Look how they did good to the seed of Abraham. They were blessed. They weren't cursed.

Like it says in Gen 12:3, whoever does good to that seed (we're that seed throughout the world establishing the 12 tribes), whoever shows good, He will totally take that into account. He sees something in them that still has the conscience. The conscience has still been preserved. He will do good to them. He will not treat them like the goats. They will not lose their reward. We have such a GOOD God. I'm so thankful to be delivered from that false Baal, it's either heaven or hell, nothing anywhere else, just playing on harps for eternity. Our God is full. He is full of vision and purpose for us. He's revealed His eternal purpose to us! We understand. He's revealing His heart to us. We understand His judgment! And we, as a people can take on His counsel. We can render righteous judgment too. Because He's revealing this to us, He's giving us the handle we need in order to reach into those people that are being kept for the holy city and bring them out. They're going to respond. If we can get to them, we'll quicken them. And even if they're going toward the second death, if there's something in them that can respond, mercy can be extended to them. That's what we've all received. I was so happy tonight when I thought somehow, for sure I don't understand it but obviously He must have kept me from going beyond that boundary that would have caused me to be debased, turned over, settled.

He rendered help (Heb 1:14) to keep us from going beyond the limits of our conscience. He gave help to those who would inherit eternal salvation. He gave help to us. He knew our heart. He didn't let us go over the waterfall.

The reason we're not to let anyone from outside teach us is because they're not holy (1 Jn 2:27). The only people who are holy are those in whom the Holy Spirit dwells. They're the holy ones. They're His dwelling place. There's been a lot of false anointings down through the centuries. Our Master said that even in His day many thieves and robbers came before him. False Messiahs and teachers have come before us convincing people they have eternal life without the body, without the twelve tribes. There's no salvation outside of Israel, outside the Body of Messiah. There's no salvation outside of the Holy Nation. The holy nation is the nation the Holy Spirit dwells in.

A body is a dwelling place. The body means the dwelling place of your spirit. Your body houses your spirit. It functions. It carries out your desires. Many, many false anointings came before us that didn't produce the fruit of the truth. There wasn't any unity, devotion, love laying down of their lives. There wasn't any power of the Holy Spirit. There's no dwelling place. He didn't have a body to dwell in yet.

It only can happen in the days of those ten kings. The restoration can only happen, the God of heaven will set up His kingdom in the days of those ten kings. The ten kings weren't alive back in 1844. They're just now coming about, the world ecumenical movement, the world council of churches, and the one-world government

are just now forming. All of these things are just now coming about. *We're* just now coming about simultaneously, in the days of those ten kings. The God of Heaven is going to set up His kingdom of twelve tribes in the days of those ten kings. Everything else will fall before that, promising people salvation when they didn't actually have salvation. They weren't led by the Spirit. Only those who are led by the Spirit are the sons of God (Dan 2:44; 7:24; Rev 17:12).

We're not going to go up on a mountain somewhere and wait for Jesus to come back and he never comes back and then we think of something else. That's just the fabrication of liars. Their place is in the Lake of Fire. They should have lived by their conscience instead of saying the Holy Spirit dwelt in them, when there's no evidence of it, no proof of it. We're brothers and sisters. We love one another. We have warm affection for one another. We know that we've passed out of death into life because we love one another. We're here. We're not going to run out on each other. We're loyal and true.

Asher: When you were talking I realized the reality of *holy* because there's the filthy, the righteous, and the holy. There haven't been a lot of holy people. That's what our Father's always wanted, a holy nation. Up to Abraham all he had was a lot of righteous people. There's been a lot of righteous people who have lived by their conscience. Every man has had a chance at that. But not every man has had a chance at holiness. Holiness is dedicated to Yahweh. There's a passage that says, in the next age even the bold will be Holy unto the Sovereign. It made me think there's going to be a dedicated, set apart nation. They'll be totally set apart. But right now He hasn't got it. Right now He's just gotten hold of *us*. And we're becoming holy. What qualifies us is, we've died. The only thing that makes you holy is the Holy Spirit. Being good doesn't make you holy, it makes you righteous. You're righteous, but it doesn't mean you're holy.

Being righteous means you *do* right, the right thing.

Asher: But holiness means you died and the Holy Spirit has come to live in you. God is not going to be dishing *that* out to just anybody. That's like pouring something into a container with holes. You wait till you've got something that is going to **hold it** before you pour something valuable into it. So He hasn't been able to get it. The container's been full of holes. He hasn't been able to get a holy people. Thankfully now, He's getting some people who are dedicated to Him. They've died. We've given up our egos and our foolish, vain existence and now we're dedicated. We've given our lives up and died so He could *trust* us. What an honor, that God can trust us with His very Spirit! It's the Spirit that raises dead people. We're dead ourselves.

We have to give up our past experience, our past religious experience and denominations. We have to renounce everything. In order for the Holy Spirit to live in us we have to renounce everything and start anew. We have to be born again.

Asher: That's encouraging, He hasn't had a holy people for a long time because He hasn't had a dwelling.

That's right. If you can't see that, then you're not one of the *you* when our Master said, "You will know a tree by it's fruit" (Mt 7:15-20). If you don't know a tree, then you're not one of the *You* who can know a tree by it's fruit. Then you're just one of those worthless people that think everything in Christianity is okay. It's okay, these past movements and these deceivers that come along and say you have eternal life when you don't. Where do they get their impetus? Where do they get their power from to deceive people? They're servants of the evil one, of course. There was no fruit. There was no nation. There was no kingdom. The God of heaven would set up a kingdom. The restoration of all things has to come about. If you don't know anything about the restoration of all things then you don't know anything about anything. We've got to know who we are. There hasn't been a Holy people on earth, a new wineskin.
