The Three Eternal Destinies #41Murder: Blood Pollutes the Land

The inhabitants of (the land), earth in Isa 24:5-6 who did not necessarily or actually murder with their own hands by Rom 1:32, are held guilty and the blood is on their hands. By not speaking up as watchmen, but passively going along with the flow and not training their children and confirming them in their conscience (TV, Media), they polluted the land.

Murder

A murderer must be put to death. He cannot escape the death sentence by any other means, not by a FINE or PRISON SENTENCE, even LIFE — 99 YEARS! (Num 35:33; Gen 9:6; Num 35:31). The land will still be polluted. The land cannot escape becoming defiled if the murderer is not executed by death — the FASTER the BETTER!

Murder defiles the land (Rom 1:32). If man goes along with only a life sentence or parole, the land will be corrupted. All who applaud bad laws will go to the Second Death as well, especially those who vote them in or vote for the politician who advocates them. Let it be certain that we know this: Murder defiles the land and except by the death of the murderer there is no way to keep the land from becoming polluted with blood-guiltiness. Those who are responsible for bad laws are just as guilty as the murderer or homosexual, or any other criminal, or those who vote for them.

Do not defile the land where you are living. Blood defiles the land. The only atonement that can be made for the land for the blood that is shed on it is the blood of him who shed it.

Murder defiles the land and must be atoned for (Num 35:33) or the land will be defiled (verse 34). Gen 9:5 — Surely your lifeblood I will require and also from every beast. I will require it, and from the hand of man. From the hand of every man's brother I will require the life of man. Gen 9:5 — Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God He made man.

God does not regard man (Noah, Shem, Yapheth, or Châm) as depraved. God breathed life into man. Man was made in the image of God and after His likeness (Gen 1:26; 9:6). *Man is God's unique, spiritual,*

immortal, intelligent (creation) counterpart.

So God commands, "You shall not murder" (Ex 20:13). To take a human life is to assault God and His image in man, to despise His law in a man's conscience (Rom 2:14). The Righteous in Rev 22:11 and the Holy respect human life, but not the Unjust and Filthy.

Pre-natal life is a miracle and no one should feel he has the right to shed blood of an innocent human being. Gen 9:5 — The wordrequire indicates that God was doing more than simply saying a rule. He was saying that He will actually pursue or seek a man's life in payment for the innocent life he has taken. Let no disrespect for human life come into anyone's mind and defile his conscience, for just as surely as it does, MAN WILL defile the land, even though He takes great measures to clean it up environmentally (Pr 12:10) in principle.

The command in Gen 9:1 says that God blessed Noah and his sons and said, "Have MANY children so that your descendants will live all over the earth."

Isa 24:5-6 — The curse is that few men are left. Most have violated God's Vice Regent, the conscience. All mankind knows instinctively Gen 9:5-6; Rom 2:14-16; Rom 1:32,28,26,24,20-18.

Gen 9:1 does not allow for one selfish abortion and verses 5 & 6 do not allow for one murderer not to be executed. Just one murdered victim is a slam in the face of God, the Creator, and one murderer set free or not executed or put in prison, even for life, will pollute a land and it will permeate the *whole loaf*, even as when the First Church did not execute, excommunicate, and justly deal with sin and spiritual murderers (1 Jn 3:15; 4:20; Rev 18:24; 19:2-3).
