Everybody Will Hear the Voice of the Son of God

Jn 5:24-29 — I read this for Sebastian [our guest from Holland who has been staying with us since a while].

Verse 25 — “...shall live eternally...” Verse 28 — “...don't marvel; don't be surprised, Pharisees.” The Pharisees didn't know that the people in the nations would be resurrected to a resurrection of life if they did good deeds.

Here we are, we have the believers in verses 24 and 25, and also those who have never had the opportunity to hear the gospel in verses 28 and 29. They will be judged according to their deeds. They all are going to hear His voice and come forth to judgment. Our Father gave Yahshua the right to judge. Those who did the evil deeds will come to a resurrection of judgment.

We are thankful you are here, Sebastian. You are drawn to our Master. Our Father has led you.

John 6:44 — No one, not even you, Sebastian, can come to our Master unless the Father draws him. If you hear His voice now, even if you die you will hear His voice in the tomb.

Verse 45 — Every day, especially in the morning and evening minchah, we are being taught, trained as disciples to rule — in the next age the earth, and in the eternal age the universe. You are chosen for that, Sebastian, if you believe, that means if you trust in the One who has been sent by the Father. Faith comes by hearing. Faith is only given for one reason — to obey Yahshua, to obey Him the rest of your life. We have to obey. Everything we do is by faith. Otherwise it's sin. We are sinning when we wash dishes if it's not done by faith. We do it because our Father wants us to do it, and we hear His voice.

Jn 5:28,29 talks about the second resurrection. The second resurrection is based on works. That life is based on works. Our life is based on salvation.
