

The Three Eternal Destinies #75 *The Vision of Habakkuk*

Heb 10:35 — Don't cast away your confidence. Verse 38 — Now the just will live by his faithfulness. This is taken from Hab 2:2-4. Write the vision, make it easily comprehensible that the one who reads it may run with it.

It's at the appointed time, not before the appointed time, no matter how much you want it to come before.

It can't come unless there is a people who are doing the will of God (Heb 10). Our Master can't come back unless our Father's will is done.

We have to live by our faithfulness. Hab 2:4 — If we live by our faithfulness we'll enter the kingdom. The people in the world live by their faithfulness to their conscience. Hab 2:4 — Then Habakkuk goes on to talk about the just, holy, unjust, and filthy.

Isa 53:10-11 — His soul experienced anguish in death. Therefore, He shall see His seed, and prolong the days of His seed in order to bring about the will of YHWH (Mt 21:43; 24:14; Heb 10:13; Rev 11:15; 20:1-2; Isa 58:14; Gen 15:18). He will see the labor of His soul in death, the fruit of His soul, and be satisfied. He will see that He got what He paid for. Up until now He hasn't got it. He paid a great price for a people who would do His will. As it happened, Christianity came about. Isa 58:12 is still in waiting, so in verse 14, *then* is also still in waiting. He got shortchanged. Sometimes we shortchange Him when we don't do His will, when we lose our confidence (Heb 10:35-36).

The vision, His will, must be written on tablets so people can see where they are at, then the filthy and unjust, and even the righteous will be able to see themselves in order to receive our Master's life. It must be written down so that it's easily comprehensible and people can run with it. We need the comprehensive gospel, the understanding of the will of our Father, so we can endure in it and do it. Then our Master is going to come back, but not before.
