

## The Training of our Children

We ought to be training our children as Yoceph and Miriam filled their Son with wisdom, so that by the age of twelve He was able to speak on the level of the learned Pharisees and scribes. Our Master Yahshua was able to do this without in the least bit relying upon divinity to do any one thing in His whole life on earth. He lived as a human being, trusting His Father in heaven by the grace of God upon Him. And we and our own children have no disadvantage in comparison to our Master Yahshua as adults or as children or as youth. The Spirit of Yahweh is upon our children. We dedicate our children just as He was dedicated. The Spirit is no less upon our children than He was upon our Master Yahshua. If it were not so, we would be disadvantaged and would not have one chance to achieve obeying His commands. The Spirit is upon our children. The parents impart wisdom to their children in the same way as Yoceph and Miriam did. They were not supernatural or divine parents, but the very same flesh and blood as we are.

Lk 2:40 — He became this way under their care, as parents who followed the pattern of Gen 18:19, as do all the descendants of Abraham who have eternal life.

Our children will be taught from 6-12. From infants until age six, they will be trained. They can be taught because they have been trained to be taught. Unless the training is complete, the teacher will not be able to teach, for the child is not able to be taught, for he is not teachable until he is trained. It is the parents' responsibility to train their child to be taught.

Our children from the age of 6-12 must be taught the word until Bar/Bat Mitzvah. Included in this training in the Word of God from childhood will be *The Three Eternal Destinies of Man* teachings and the *Two Ransoms* series.

2 Tim 3:15 — From childhood (#1025) until Bar Mitzvah — until youthhood.

Lk 2:40 — “The Child grew and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom, and the grace of God was upon Him.” *Filled* is #4137 — this is a verb: to fill, to fill up, to supply with, to accomplish or perform, to complement. This was accomplished by the parents according to the commandments, starting in Gen 18:19, and the proverbs concerning wisdom for parents. This wisdom was imparted to our Master Yahshua through the efforts of those whom God had entrusted.
