

The Baring of the Holy Arm

Do you remember the day you received faith? Something was revealed to you that you didn't know before. Revelation was given from the Holy Spirit to persuade you to trust in Yahshua so you'd call on His name, believing God raised Him from the dead. The righteousness of our God was revealed. Faith is revelation. It's yours, passed on from generation to generation. True faith is. When you received revelation you were sealed with the Spirit. Something was uncovered that you didn't know before. It's completely sealed. You always will have faith because you got faith. It's ours forever. It will take us to the end.

Faith is given to us so that we will obey. Apart from obedience we only would have a futile existence, like Christianity. Remember when it came to you, gave you promise, approached you? That's the day you were sealed in baptism. Whoever endures to the end has to have true faith. We have faith, but we don't even know what it is. We have to pass it on to our children. A lot of parents haven't passed it on. If you have faith you can give faith.

When we have our baptisms, we baptize in front of everyone. Everyone should be so certain about you getting baptized because you pass on faith, revelation to all of us. Sometimes it wasn't like that; we didn't really know. The *Amen* should be resounding. A lot of times people aren't so sure. Anyway we just have to think the best.

It goes from faith to faith. If you received faith it continues, grows, gets greater and greater. It doesn't decrease, because faith comes by hearing. That's why faith increases, because we're baptized into a place where we hear the word continually and those who have faith pass on faith. Only those who are full of faith will be taken up with our Master when He comes back. They'll be part of that Stone Kingdom, that great army our Father uses to pour out His indignation on those who aligned themselves with Satan (Rev 17:14).

He'll retake the earth from the evil one. But this will only happen when He has a faithful people.

2 Ths 1:8 speaks of those who have heard the good news but didn't obey it, rejected our Master Yahshua. They treated Him as scum, as something to be rejected. If He allowed these people to keep on propagating, you can imagine what would happen. They treated Yahshua's word as refuse, garbage. You have to hear the gospel in order to disobey it, to reject it. The whole world will hear it.

Isa 52:10 — His holy arm will be revealed. It will be bared in the sight of all the nations *Bared* — like when you take up the sword, when you lift it up, your sleeve comes down. This talks about the word of God that's being proclaimed in all the earth. We have to know and understand the word before He can bare His arm before the nations.

Isa 53:1; 52:10; 51:9 — To whom has the arm of the Sovereign been revealed, and who has believed our Message? The gospel is the power of God unto salvation for all those who trust, believe, obey. That's the revelation a person needs to have before he can be saved. The arm of YHWH represents the power of God unto salvation.

That's how the bride, the wife of the lamb is going to make herself ready, through proclaiming the good news to the whole world.

Shua [*who is about to be married*] represents the whole Twelve Tribes, the Bride of the Lamb, His wife.

Isa 52:10-15 — The arm is going to be revealed to the world. This is going to startle, sprinkle the whole world soon.

A person who is going to battle takes a sword. He rolls up his sleeve for action.

Our children will be learning and understanding the good news from six years up. They'll grow up understanding it. That's the first roll of the sleeve. Then it goes up until we're continually saturated with understanding. Only those who have faith can do it. That faith has to be imparted into our children. We haven't been faithful to teach our children the gospel even though we've been instructed many years ago. We see the results, even here in Sus. They need to have understanding as they grow up into *Bar Mitzvah*. Then the Holy Spirit is right there. That's the bride being prepared to be taken to be with our Master to pour out

wrath and indignation upon the nations.
