We are Judged by our Deeds

We can be forgiven, but still it's our works that make us deserving of ruling with our Master. We are judged by our deeds (2 Cor 5:10; Rev 19:8; Eph 2:10). When we work with a bad conscience it's a bad work. Rev 17:14 — The faithful are taken up, those who endure to the end. Rev 19:8; 19:14 — They have a white shining linen garment on. They did right.

What if we are faithful with having our children do oral reports? When our children are twelve years old should not they be like our Master who astounded all who heard Him with the wisdom He had at this age?

We can do it. We're no different than the parents of Yahshua. He had parents who put into Him all the training and understanding He had. Do not our children have parents who can do the same?
