Hab 2:2 — The revelation was no*given* directly to Habakkuk, for it *awaits* it's *appointed time* in history. In the end *it will speak*, and it speaks of the end.

So the revelation *must* be recorded and written down on *tablets*. Not only must the subject on the signboard be easily read, but *the message* also must be written in very understandable language, made plain and comprehensible.

Hab 2:2 — Be sure to make iplain, very plain on Poster Board or maybe signboard. They should be poster s so that everyone who passes by may be able to read it easily. He must be able to read it quickly as he hastens by.

<u>Plain</u> means unobstructed, not intricate, clear, obvious, easily understood, simple, apparent, comprehensible, distinct, evident, legible, manifest, unmistakable, visible, not ornamental (unattractive).

Revelation is a message from God given through a prophet (1 Chr 17:15). This is the beginning of the final revelation which will illuminate the whole earth (Rev 18:1). Hab 1:5 as quoted in Acts 13:41 had nothing to do with Babylon (Chaldeans, Hab 1:6). But now the prophet applies this to the effect of the twelve tribes (Isa 52:15 and (Hab 1:4) of the *Three Eternal Destinies of Man* message, especially upon the Christianized world. The fruit of the kingdom in Mt 21:43 and Mt 24:14 will have a startling effect upon the nations (Isa 52:15).

The (especially) prophetic and evangelistic brothers and sisters will more and more be set apart to "table" in downtown sections where appropriate and allowed, with a sign board publicizing the title of the booklets to be given away:

The Three Eternal Destinies of Man

They will be written as 1-12 polished arrows, exhausting the revelation of the Three Eternal Destinies of Man — if, that is, ican be exhausted. At any rate, the message will be exhaustive or *comprehensive*, c overing the subject completely and considering all its elements. Every person alive today falls into one of the three categories in Rev 22:11, and this will be comprehensible to every person alive.
