

The Three Eternal Destinies #138 *Deceiving the Nations, Part 5*

The Righteous and the Sons of Disobedience

The Righteous, as spoken of in Mt 25:34,46, are those who were not led astray from the Everlasting Covenant of Isa 24:5. This is the covenant in Gen 3:16-19 and 9:1-7, which Satan endeavors to *lead* the whole world astray from. These boundaries are where the Righteous of the world *walk* (Rev 22:11). “The unjust and filthy” are the sons of disobedience. “The Righteous” are not the sons of disobedience. They were not led astray from the Everlasting Covenant. They kept the covenant with conscience (Rom 2:6,7,10).

The sons of disobedience did not keep the covenant with their conscience (Rom 2:8,9,14-16). Verse 16 is the judgment in Heb 9:27 by which all who die and go into death in the world must face to determine their eternal destiny. This judgment will determine and verify all their deeds (Rom 2:6), whether good or evil. Gen 3:22 assures that all men knew the difference between. The very things that conscience knows the difference between are the very things that make one worthy of a second life or a second death, as Rev 21:8 says.

The first two classes of those worthy of the second death are Jn 3:18 and 36. They are the *fearful and not believing* or obeying the Son or the gospel (Acts 5:32; Heb 5:9; Rom 10:16). As Acts 13:46 says, they judge themselves unworthy of eternal life. Plus the rest of the sins in Rev 21:8 when Satan led them astray from the Everlasting Covenant of Gen 3:16-19 and 9:1-7.

Satan leads astray also by the *New Kid on the Block*, like Tommy Davis, who had already been led astray and made into a son of disobedience. He led me astray from my daddy’s advice and influence – peer pressure was the greater influence. I wanted to please Tommy more than my own dad. I became a deceiver myself – I would pretend obedience to my dad. I would lie to him to cover for my evil deeds. Then I was set up to become a “good son of disobedience.” My father then became Satan, even as the religious system today. Jn 8:44 is the avenue of the greatest influence Satan has today (Jn 9:41).

Rev 19:2-3 — Deceiving and corrupting the whole world. Rev 18:23 says the whole world (Rev 12:9 and 20:3,8).

So by what means does Satan *deceive* or lead astray the whole world today? Remember, if Adam and Eve and all their descendents were already so deceived and led astray from, and incapable of keeping the course designed by God for man to keep in Gen 3:16-19, what was the use of this everlasting covenant and of a man’s conscience? Of what use was Gen 3:22, and why was there the big ordeal of Gen 4:7? Why was it important for Moses to write it down and for whom did he write it down? (1 Cor 10:11; Rom 15:4). God gave Adam and his children the right way to go and put this right way to go in their hearts (Rom 2:15). Even though man has his weak or fallen side – his conscience is given to him so that he could have chosen at least this second life (Gen 6:5).

The sons of Cain influenced all the sons of Seth – except Noah and his family. But, after the flood Gen 9:1-7 is the extension of the Everlasting Covenant of Isa 24:5. And as it was in the days of Noah so shall it be in the days of the coming of the Lord (Mt 24:37).

So why does Satan work to lead the whole world astray if they are already led astray as much as they can be? Why does he do so if all are going to his punishment anyway? That is, if they don’t become saved somehow in the middle of the jungle? In reality the prospects for true salvation are no greater or worse in the USA or England, France, Germany, or even Rome or anywhere else in this evil world for the last 1900 years – ever since Rev 2:4-5. So now 1900 years later true salvation is being offered once more, if you have ears to hear what the Spirit says to “the Churches.”

So today, again Heb 3 and 4. If you hear My voice do not harden your hearts. Rev 3:20 proves that the churches were not being *heard* by Messiah (1 Jn 3:23; 5:14-15), since His voice was not being heard by the Churches (Rev 3:21). They were the *foolish disciples* of Mt 25:2 who would not go to the throne of grace (Heb 4:16). So Rev 12:9 is the very last days. 1900 years later on in history Satan is still leading the world astray, with the *Church* still being used by Satan to do it (Rev 18:23; 19:2), having now become the dwelling place of every kind of demon (Rev 18:2). Satan *roared* and the churches in

the second century succumbed to Rome and the Bishopric system that Satan used to lead the whole twelve tribes astray from the path, the way, devouring the flock (Acts 20:29-30).

In Rev 12:9 we see his effectual influence upon the whole world and even upon the restored twelve-tribed woman, the Edah, to lead whomever he can astray from becoming the overcomers. Only a few in the first century had not stained their garments (Rev 3:4), and even now Rev 3:21 is still open to us – whenever we stray from the course set before us. 2 Tim 4:7-8 — To be wise disciples we must love His appearing, be prepared and ready (Lk 1:17; Rev 19:7-8), to meet Him in the air (1 Ths 4:14-18). At the time of Rev 17:14 we must not be those who shrink back. We must be those who have the hope of 1 Jn 2:27-28 and 4:17 (Heb 9:28; 10:38; 1 Jn 3:2-3; Rom 5:4-5).
