Recognizing the Real One

Mt 10:25-26 — If the head of the household is called Beelzebub, then the (other) members of his household will be called worse names. So don't be afraid of these people, because everything that is hidden will be shown. Everything that is secret will be made known.

Who is the head of the house today? Is He the same Son that the writer of the Book of Hebrews records in Heb 3:6? 1 Cor 14:24-25 gives us the knowledge of how Paul thought the Church must be in order for someone to know that Immanuel was the true Son over His House — "the Real One."

1 Jn 5:20 — John wrote in a way that gives us understanding as to who is in the Body of the Son (1 Jn 5:11-12). This exposes the religions of this world (1 Jn 5:19). We can say we are in Him who is *real*, since we are in His Son, Yahshua ha Mashiyach, and this is the true God. This is eternal life.

So we are in constant watch for false spirits, which are constantly working to enter in. 1 Jn 4:1 speaks of falsely, errantly inspired "Doctors of Divinity" who come to us with their "divine" knowledge learned by rote in *amonas tery*-like learning club called a *college*.

College: 1. a body of clergy living together and supported by a foundation; 2. a society of scholars incorporated for study or instruction in the higher branches of knowledge; 3. a body of persons having common interests or corporate functions (Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary).

1 Jn 2:27 — We only recognize the credentials of those who are enrolled for life in the *University of Yahshua*, which is the Body of Messiah, the Twelve Tribes of Israel.

2 Cor 11:15 — Satan is the father of liars (Jn 8:44), which are his servants. Pr 17:4 — A liar is always ready to believe a lie. Bob Pardon's ministry is only to liars (Rev 21:8; Jn 16:1-3).

Evildoer in Pr 17:4 is *râ'a*(#7489) — to be injurious, to break up or shatter all that is good or desirable; a wicked, good-for-nothing, worthless kind of person.

The morally depraved listen to liars, the wicked-doers, those who gossip and hurt others without concern for their reputation (since the one who gossips is depraved).

2 Cor 11:15 — Satan's ministers or servants give "assistance" (even as Heb 1:14), continually serving, imactive d uty, advancing the ministry of Satan, making to grow his religion (Rev 18:2). It is not surprising and no great thing that Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light (2 Cor 11:14), therefore also his servants as ministers work continually to transform themselves into ministers of righteousness. Jn 7:18 — They work to appear to be those who seek the glory of Jesus, which in fact they do — another Jesus (2 Cor 11:4), by the power of another spirit and another gospel, even as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness (1 Cor 3:18-19; 2 Pet 2:19). *Deceptive scheming* refers to Satan deceiving Eve, and all who seek their own glory work for Satan (Jn 7:18; 9:41; 2 Cor 4:2-3; 11:13). They are deceitful workers, transforming themselves (2 Cor 11:3), preaching by the power of Satan in versatile cleverness, sophisticated cunning. 2 Pet 2:19, NKJV — For by whom a person is overcome, by him also he is brought into bondage.
