If the foundations are destroyed, what can, what will, the Righteous do? Ps 11:3

Foundations is #8356, the **basis** of moral support from government; of political support for morality in public and private life. The foundations are the *basis* of *morality* (Gen 9:1-7, and especially verses 5 and 6; Rom 1:32).

The Basis of Government

Basis (Webster's Dictionary):

- a. The foundation of any thing; that on which a thing stands or lies, the bottom or foot of the thing itself, or that on which it rests;
 - b. The groundwork or first principle; that which supports;
 - c. Foundation; support.

The foundation is Gen 9:6. If this goes, all goes. If the foundations are destroyed what can the righteous do? (Ps 11:3). But Ps 9:17-18 says that someday judgment will be rendered in favor of the righteous (Ps 9:8).

Ps 10:13 and Ps 14:1 lead to Isa 24:5-6 – where the inhabitants of the earth are burned and few men are left (who obey conscience). Isa 24:6 is prophesied in Ps 11:4-7, which describes God's righteous judgment upon the wicked and those who love violence. *Fire and brimstone and burning wind will be the portion of their cup* (verse 6).

Ps 12:8 – The wicked prowl on every side, promoted by civil authorities and media. Even in such a day there are still the Righteous (Ps 11:3; 9:8). But when the moral foundations of the Earth go down and crumble, the Earth goes with it. Ps 9:7 – His throne for judgment will be set up for those who have violated the everlasting covenant of conscience (Isa 24:5).
