## The Three Eternal Destinies #178The Message to the Nations

"The Three Eternal Destinies of Man" must be presented in such a way that is understood (irresistibly sure and certain) even as Dan 2:45. In the same way, the Stone Kingdom must be presented in no uncertain terms also. The *presentation* and its *interpretation* must be as equally certain as the dream itself. The proclamation of the Stone Kingdom must be as equally sure as the dream is certain.

## Mankind has a Choice

Obadiah 15 — "The Day of Yahweh is near for all the nations. As you have done, it will be done to you. Your dealings will return on your own head."

*Obadiah 15 is the message to the nations*. The Three Eternal Destinies give all mankind a *choice*— to decide what their eternal destiny will be, even as Obadiah 15 says. Unless Obadiah 15 is heard, 2 Ths 1:8-10 and 2:10-12 cannot be true.

Tribulation and distress will come upon all nations as a result of not heeding this message (Lk 21:25-27).

## We Also have a Choice

Regardless of how smart a person may be, unless he has a *personal relationship* with God he cannot *endure* in the community (Mt 24:13; Rom 8:7-9; Eph 3:12; Heb 4:16; 1 Pet 1:8,22; 1 Cor 16:22). He cannot endure unless he prayS (Lk 18:1).
