

## Fellowship Forms the Pearl

**It probably takes a long time for that pearl to be formed. Paul said 1 Cor 1:10, “I plead with you...” because he knew there were divisions among them. He was pleading with them that they be perfectly joined together. That’s what makes a tribe — that every person in every household is perfectly joined together. Then they would be fully deserving of Him, like a bride having been made compatible.**

**That is, if** we are in fellowship with him (1 Cor 1:9). We are called to have fellowship with His Son. Words can hardly describe what fellowship is, but that is what we are called to — communion.

Neriah — I used to think that doing things right was doing it how I thought it should be done, but I know that’s not what our Abba wants.

That fellowship, being joined together, is a partnership — side by side, working together — that we would be in partnership with Him. We must learn this now, because we are going to be ruling over the universe one day in partnership with Him.

Yacob — I saw that it is a joint effort and the layering of the pearl is our Father’s doing.

Jn 17:22 — We have all received that glory. The glory He receives from the Father, He passes it on to those He is in partnership with. It is the glory from the Godhead, expressed outwardly in what we do and how we do it, and what we say and how we say it, and it bonds us together. It makes us respect one another and it bonds us together in perfect unity. It is amazing that you have come here [to the minchot] 1,400 times since we were last here and not one time has anyone come here out of fellowship or doubting what our Father said to us, but in peace, unity, and love. And as we go on that way it is amazing what he is going to make us to be. And if we realize that we come here out of fellowship, we are going to do something about it. Our Father is going to have many sons.

Haggai — Many times He cannot speak to us because we are not ready, not willing; we hinder Him. But to realize that He wants to speak to us, that we have come 1,400 times and He always wanted to speak to us. Like we sang in the song, “fellowship with you is all I want to give myself to...” — that’s why I need to come here with my eyes open and my ears ready to hear what He wants to say.
