

Living Water

Jn 4:14 – The woman came to the well. She wanted to get water to take home. She needed water to live. This was Jacob's well. Water is essential for life.

The story is there in John 4. Our Master was talking to her about living water in verse 13. He said "this" water will make you thirst again, but whoever drinks, whoever wants and drinks that which I shall give will never thirst anymore. But the water I give will become a well springing up in him. It will become a source of eternal life. If she received Him, she would never thirst again, and will receive eternal life.

Jn 7:37-39 – If we believe in Him and drink the water of life, then rivers of living water can come from us. That really shows whether we have life in us or not. We have to keep that river flowing. His Spirit could not come down until He was glorified. When His Spirit was given, they knew our Master had been glorified.

Rev 21:6-8 – If you are still thirsty, that means that you are being drawn, and you don't have eternal life yet.

Jn 4:24 – Worship what you don't know? We must worship in spirit and truth. The spirit is the immaterial aspect of us. It is the unseen part of us that dwells in us, that worships somebody.

We were connected to the world's spirits, and now we're connected to the Spirit of life, not through our brain, but with our spirit. You see our spirit in action on the things we do. No one could see what God was like until they saw our Master, walking on the earth. God is love. If we're connected to His Spirit, we'll produce love. Apples come from apple trees. Love comes from the true tree, the tree of life.

When Yahshua was on the earth, you could tell what God was like through Him, and now a Body is being raised up, that is going to represent our Master's Spirit to this earth. We have to be totally connected to His Spirit.

Obviously the immaterial aspect of our personality needs to be connected to Messiah. We are one spirit with Him. We are not just allies, we're one in Spirit. When the enemy comes on, we're allied against that evil. Even NATO has allied forces.

Worship and *serve* is almost the same word. Our body is the servant of our soul. The soul is connected to the spirit, and the spirit is connected to the immaterial realm. Our spirit used to be connected to somewhere, but now we're connected to Him.

Jn 6:44 – No one can come to me, where I dwell, unless the Father draws him, and I will raise him up on the last day, because we have eternal life (**Jn 12:26**). Our Master will not leave us as orphans. He won't leave us fatherless. That's where we were drawn, to that place. Our Father drew us. He has a drawing effect, a magnetic effect. Like metal, we're drawn to that magnet. Wherever the Son was, we had the right material in us that we were drawn. He is like a magnet, and we were willing to do His will. We are drawn. We have *mettle* in us.

Mettle – Character, courage, temper, ardour, high courage (same word as *metal*, used in allusion to the temper of the metal of a sword blade), high-spirited, full of fire, fiery.

Jn 6:51 – The bread of life — it's the same as water. You need it to live. You need bread also. You've got to have bread and water. If you don't eat food or water you will die. We can eat the bread of life, and we will receive eternal life. The bread is His body, and if we eat from Him we will never see death.

Verse 41 – "I am the living bread. The bread that I will give is my own body." Eat of Him, the Bread of Life. Now we partake of Him. That's what it means to have eternal life. It's like taking one bite from that Bread, and we're satisfied. We eat physical bread every day, but if we eat of Him, and drink of Him, we don't hunger after that spiritual life. One bite and we were satisfied (verse 46). The bread is symbolic of this life.

This is what upset the Pharisees (**Jn 7:37**). He attracted the crowds, drew them. "If anyone thirsts let Him come to me and drink; he who believes, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

If you receive a true disciple, then you receive Yahshua. We're reconnected with God. We made friends with Him. If you receive Yahshua, then you are reconnected to God. A friend loves at all times. We are brothers allied in the same cause. Brothers are born for adversity.

Does living water flow from you? That is the proof, it is the acid test. We need to believe in Him as the

Scriptures say. What does it mean to trust in Him? There's no place our Master dwells in, except in a people who have eaten that Bread, and drunk that Water. We must keep that water flowing (Jn 7:39).

When He arose again, a coronation was held in His honor. He defeated the enemy, and so He could give the Water and Bread of life. When He was glorified, we could receive His Spirit. Ten days later, when He disappeared before them, He reached His destination. His Spirit wasn't given until He was glorified. They got His Spirit.

This is like when our brothers go on a trip and have to cross the border, and we don't know whether they crossed safely or not. We can only know if they contact us in some way, saying we made it to the other side. When the Holy Spirit was given, they knew that He had reached His destination, and was glorified. They received His Spirit, and there were 3000 people saved in one day. The immaterial aspect of our being received His Spirit. Your spirit is what looks out of your eyeballs.

Rev 21:6 – “It is done.” What does this mean? This means that everything is completed — the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end — all authority. “I will give a fountain of life freely to him who thirsts.” This is speaking of the Holy Spirit whom we give to others. If they're thirsty they are drawn. They don't have eternal life. If you are thirsty, then you haven't drunk. Only when you have drunk from Him are you no longer thirsty.

Our Father has saved us from going straight to the second death. He is the author of eternal life.

Rev 22:17 – The Spirit and the Bride say “Come!” Both the Spirit and the Bride. The Spirit dwells in the Bride. Together they say, “Come!”

“I'll bring you home. Let him who hears also say, ‘Come!’ Let him who thirsts come, and whoever desires, let him take hold of eternal life, and drink of it freely.”

Eternal life is not imposed upon anyone, but He gives it freely to those who want it. He who believes and opens his heart will inherit these things — the universe. We were guilty of almost all of those abominable things spoken of in Rev 21:8, but we were not cowards, because we responded.

Faith comes by hearing. Whoever desires will drink, by his own will. We're not robots. Our Abba does not want robots. He has given people a free will to choose. I'm free to do of my own accord, and willingly I lay down my life.

Rev 21:6 – I will give the fountain of life to him who thirsts. What do you need to do to receive that? We must overcome the Evil One to whom our spirit was joined. We can only overcome by hearing the Gospel. Come out of him. Come out of the domain of darkness, and come into His domain, the Kingdom of light. We have to overcome what has been put into us all of our lives, through education, the media, etc., etc.

Verse 7 — “And then I'll be his God, and he'll be my son.” They have to hear the Good News and respond by opening up their hearts.

Verse 8 talks about people who don't want it. They want physical food, but not eternal life. These are worthless people, people who don't come, who don't receive the Gospel. Their lives don't benefit anyone. They're cowards, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, etc. But we weren't cowards because we heard the truth and did something about it. Cowards, meaning those who don't respond, and those who don't believe are the first two classifications of the first category.

Thousands of people have never heard the truth. They've only heard Catholics, Anglicans, Methodists, the lies of Martin Luther, and John Calvin, etc. But there was no true life in their words. Sorcerers preach the Gospel in another spirit, and thus unite everyone who receives them to that other spirit.

Idolators, such as those who go to concerts and festivals, their high places. Other gods are there. This crowd includes the sexually immoral, and all liars. We've been delivered from all that.

Rev 22:15 – The dogs and the sorcerers. Dogs can't dwell here, because they leave behind excrement everywhere. Dogs are unclean. They vomit, then return to their vomit, and eat it. They pass on unclean things — that refers to being a male prostitute.

Whoever preys on other people — doctors, lawyers, dentists, bankers, etc. — are in that first category.

We're saved from those things that were sending us to the second death. Our Father doesn't condemn people if they've only heard a Christian gospel, yet they try to live by their conscience.

I'm thankful that we've taken of the Bread of Life, and the Water of Life. We have eternal life. If you're thirsty, then you need to go to the well.
