Totally Available

How was it that the Father could do everything He intended by our Master Yahshua, His Son? Because the Son, our Master, was or kept Himself totally available to His Father. Not only was He in *union* with Him, but also in *communion* (Rev 3:20; Jn 12:44; 13:20; 12:45-46; Mt 5:14; Jn 14:7-10).

Total mutual availability — all there was of the Son was available to His Father, and all there was of the Father was available to His Son (Gal 3:26; 1 Jn 3:1-3; Jn 1:12). All there was of the Son was available to all there was of the Father, and all there was of the Father was available to all there was of the Son. This must also be true of us —as we are also with Him in the Father, through Him (Mt 12:30; Jn 14:6; 1 Cor 6:17; Jn 17:10-11; Jn 1:32).

All there is of God is available to the one who is available to all there is of God. How available was our Master, the man Yahshua the Messiah, to the Father? Totally (Jn 12:49-50) — total mutual inter-availability. No one can see God the Father except when they see His sons. Jn 17:10-11 — "So that they may be totally available to you, Father, as I was, so that they may be one as We are one" (Jn 17:16,18,21-23,25,26).
