

## The Increase of His Peace and Government

Isa 9:6 — *There shall be no end... of the increase of His government and peace... Prince of Peace* Mt 5:9 — The peacemakers will be called the very sons of God in the eternal age of peace, for they will rule forever and ever (Rev 22:5; 2:26-27; 3:21).

The nations in the coming ages will call the peacemakers in this age the *sons of God* (Mt 5:9). *Called* is #2564 (Greek).

Isa 9:6 — *Called* is #7121 (Hebrew), meaning to address someone as to who they are by name or character; to designate as such, to name. “What will you *call* the child?” (Mt 1:21).

Mt 5:9 — “Blessed are the peacemakers...” So, the peacemakers in this present age, during Satan’s reign upon earth (1 Jn 5:19), are those who make peace (#1518).

Col 1:20 — To communicate this “peace” in the spiritual realm to others, and to maintain the peace in the Body of Messiah among His people (Pr 6:19; 1 Cor 3:16-17; Isa 49:17). No one who is not a peacemaker will be called a Son of God, or be known as a Son of God on the planets of the universe among the nations of men (Rev 21:3-4,24; 22:2; Mt 25:34-46). *The nations will know us as who we are.*

The increase of His government... He is the Head of the Body — the government will rest upon His shoulders (Isa 9:6-7) — we are His shoulders, His Body. Of the increase of His government and of peace there will be no end. *Increase* in Isa 9:7 is #4768 (Hebrew), meaning a *multitude of offspring* (Gen 15:4-5), without end. This offspring of peacemakers who will bring eternal peace to the whole universe are called who they are — the sons of Elohim. Those in whom He eternally dwells will be among the nations of men (Rev 21:3). This offspring will be from each son of Elohim who is of the wife the Lamb, without end. Isa 9:7 would better be translated “of the offspring of His government and peace there shall be no end.” The natural righteous of the nations will have natural procreation and will also have no end to their offspring. The Holy Ones of the twelve tribes will never cease to be increased by spiritual offspring to govern the universe forever and ever (Rev 22:5).

*Increase* (#4766-68) of family, “offspring” of sons that never decrease, means ever-increasing to the extent that cannot be imagined, or beyond human understanding or reason (Gen 15:5), to the Milky Way and beyond. Gal 3:26,29 — As many as are the cells of the human body, so will be the number of his offspring (increase) who are the sons of God, who are the peacemakers. They come forth from those who were the first-born sons (Gen 15:4-5), through the increase of one’s body and the increase of the bodies who come forth from them, and on and on, perpetually, forever and ever. Gen 15:4 will be the holy offspring, seed (Gal 3:16,26-29).

In Isa 9:7 *increase* is better translated *offspring*. It is *marbiyth*, which has to do with offspring, not bigger and bigger government (not increased bureaucracy and oppression and intrusion in to people’s lives, etc.). But the governors will increase, which means offspring. The offspring of His governors of peacemakers will never end. *Marbiyth* is personal (human and divine) increase — that is the dwelling of God in the spirit (Eph 2:22; Rev 21:3). It is the increase or offspring of His governors who rule and reign. Those who are called the *sons of God* (Mt 5:9) by the men in Rev 21:3 will never cease in the offspring from their own bodies, from their generation. Eph 3:21 says “to all generations forever and ever.” Concerning both the righteous and the Holy in Rev 22:11, the word *still* is a term meaning forever and ever (#2089), without end.

Eph 3:21 — Generations that continue into (#165) perpetuity of the eternal age, continually increasing with the image of God in the Righteous men, ruled by the Holy who are God’s Body, His dwelling place, temple, tabernacle, etc. Eph 3:21 speaks of the future age which never ends, the eighth day (#166) — increase perpetually, lasting for eternity, never-ending, lasting for an indefinite age, unlimited expanse, continuing without interruption (Gal 3:26,29).

Those who make peace are *people* who govern personally. They are the “personal offspring” of peacemakers. So, the increase is *personal*, dealing with persons who are offspring that bring peace, governing as peacemakers.
