Stability in Our Times

Isa 33:6 — There will be stability in your times. This talks about a certain time in history in this age. I'm thankful there can be stability in our midst as you see brothers serving day and night fulfilling prophecy. Mal 1:11 is fulfilled in our midst. Servants are serving and lifting up praise continually. Paul said our twelve tribes who worship or serve day and night.

I am thankful we don't have to wash dishes for a thousand years if we wash them now with a thankful heart. But if we do it begrudgingly we will. In the next age we will be through with this testing. We probably won't eat with plates, but just pick off trees.

There is stability in Reuben, who is by nature unstable, boiling over like water.

There shall be stability in your times, an abundance of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge (Amplified Bible). The fear of YHWH is the key to this treasure (NIV). The fear of YHWH is a wonderful fear. It's clean. To rule in the fear of YHWH is fearing to hurt a person, misjudging them. Rulers don't want to misjudge. We need to pray with our whole heart to not misjudge.

There will be stability in our times. This comes about through wisdom and knowledge. There is no way to gain wisdom and knowledge except through how Proverbs 2 teaches us. There is no other way. If we don't do what Proverbs 2 says all the way, we will be like the man in the last verse (verse 22). I don't want to be like that. Those who don't acquire wisdom, discernment and knowledge will be but off. They are treacherous, not faithful or trustworthy. They will be rooted out.

Proverbs 2 is one of the greatest chapters in Proverbs. Cry out for insight, for skillful and Godly wisdom, then you will come to the fear of YHWH. Verses 1-5 (Amplified Bible) — The fear of YHWH is the key to this treasure (NIV). We have the key to this treasure, to salvation, wisdom and knowledge.

David Derush from Brazil went to this mine. He told us all about how they used to seek for silver and gold. They had to crawl back in those small little holes and get that silver out. If we seek like that for wisdom and knowledge then we will come to the fear of YHWH.

Verses 6-8 — He hides away sound and godly wisdom and stores it for the righteous. He preserves the way of His saints (Amplified Bible).

We want the key. We finally come to the fear of YHWH, the knowledge of Him. That's the key to His treasure chest. He has a treasure chest. He gives the key to it. We must acquire that key.

Wisdom and knowledge — that's our only stability — or we'll be anxiety ridden even over Klosterzimmern. But we don't need to have anxiety over Klosterzimmern. Trusting our Master casts out anxiety. He wants to give us that place.
