Woman, the Helper

Our Father has it in his plan that He would change our lives. He is not satisfied with how we are and we can't be satisfied with it either, because there is so much more our Abba has in his heart for us.

You have to have identity in the fact that one day when all of you were born someone said "It's a girl!"

Man, this infinitely amazing creature, needed a helper. There was not found a helper comparable to him. There was a big empty space, and then (Gen 2:20) it was filled — with woman! Ahhhhhh... now our Father could rest — Shabbat.

That was in Genesis 2, and then RIGHT after that is Genesis 3. This is the story of oppositional thinking. A contentious woman is an oppositional thinker. Our Master needs a bride that will be comparable to Him, who will fit in with Him. But there's nothing worse than a contentious woman. The Proverbs are full of them. It says better is the attic in the farthest barn out there than to live with an oppositional thinker. Look at the birth of oppositional thinking.

Gen 3:4-6 — It was an opportunity for her flesh, a chance to get something that she didn't have. So she opened the door up to oppose what was already taught to her. From this moment on, everything changed. Things weren't so straightforward anymore. Before it was: "That's what we said so that's what I'm going to do." Now it was "oppositional thinking." She was met face to face with an oppositional thought. It is not really until we see this thinking at work in ourselves that anything changes. It is what holds the Body back more than anything else, and it came in through woman.

Gen 3:7-9 — Then came the call, "Adam, where are you?" When we are with Him we are THERE where our Father put us. But Adam wasn't THERE anymore. We were gone. So our Father called, "Where are you?" Oh, the sad moment that it was!

When questioned Adam blamed the woman (verses 10-12), "It's the woman you gave me..."

But (verse 13) the woman, on the other hand, actually confessed her guilt. "The serpent deceived me." She was at least honest. She had listened to the serpent. It actually dawned on her that she was deceived. That is because Eve was actually a very amazing creature. If the Fall wouldn't have happened, there is no telling what she would have become....WOMAN. Right here in this room are the most powerful creatures on the earth — made impotent by their rebellion. But if she comes right back to where she is supposed to be, and puts on a headcovering, she is actually back in the place where she was before the Fall. If our Father could just have woman being just the way we were created to be — not some empty-headed gossips that spend all their time in foolish conversations and in empty-headed thoughts.

It talks about women in Proverbs. Do you know Proverbs 31 by heart? But did you notice how it starts in verse 3. This was probably written to Solomon: "Don't give your strength to women or to her ways which are the ruin of kings (rulers)." This is very important. What is the greatest hope of our Father in the twelve tribes? That He could raise up a people — humans who could ultimately rule the universe. Rulers. So it says here that HER ways are the ruin of *rulers*.

So Chanukah can either help Toviyah or ruin him. We can be either helpers or ruiners. We can either help our Master or ruin Him.

Then just a little further down in that chapter it talks about a different woman. Pr 31:10 — She gets everything

done, everything organized. This is a woman who is totally devoted to be 100% what she is supposed to be. She is so busy, but she even notices the needy person, the sister who needs help (verse 20). She's got a cottage industry going (verse 24). She has wisdom and always passes it on — what she heard in the minchah. This is us — WOMAN.

On our flag, from Rev 12:1, it's a woman. Why? Because if women can get back to where they are supposed to be, then they can turn the men around. How honored are we that woman is on the flag! If woman can get back to what she was created to be then our men will be great rulers — if she doesn't go on ruining. I hate to see this still happening today, because it's not what we were created to do, but there is something in us to ruin men.

Pr 31:27 — She does not eat the bread of idleness. She could organized herself right off the schedule, and spend all her time on herself. What a waste. She would waste her strength by doing that. But SHE, the true woman, doesn't eat the bread of idleness.

Verse 31 — Can you imagine that our works that we do will praise us at the end?

The degradation of woman is everywhere. Nowadays woman is turned into a low life — using a half-dressed woman to sell everything — and trying to get all the women to look like that unreal person on the magazine cover who actually is not even a real person. She has been cut and pasted on a fancy computer program to make her into an unattainable idol.

But not the women of the twelve tribes of Israel! You're going to see restoration, putting everything under our feet that holds us back. This includes not commanding our spirits enough to raise our voices loud enough to get our point across. Please, speak loudly in the minchot. Look at the person across from you on the other side of the room focus on them and make sure they hear you. It is like serving the ball in volleyball, when you serve you aim all the way across the net and you hit that ball just hard enough to get it over there... and not farther.

Jer 31:22 — Backsliding daughter — empty heads. But look, it's a new thing. Woman is going to get back into her position again — if you want to get out of trouble. This woman is not empty-headed. This is a prophecy from so long ago — a new woman, a new chance to be what we were supposed to be, so He can get something done on the earth. This will happen if we get behind them and be what we're supposed to be. It is so important that we get out of the vicious cycle of the ruining of rulers. This is not only talking about wives with their husbands, but corporate women and corporate men. YHWH is creating a new thing on the earth.

So WE won't be the woman in Pr 31:3. We're doing whatever we can to make sure that that is not us. If we don't, it's contention. It is contending for the crown. Contention is to take the headship away, to pull down the ruling man. That's why there are so many homosexuals these days. There are all emasculated men who have been downtrodden by strong women. And the women are switching from the gentle helpers they were supposed to be and becoming those who rise up in their own strength to take the crown. But not us. We take dominion over our old, destructive women selves.

Gen 2:20 — A helper; that's our job. In 14:16 and 15:26 talk about the Helper. Another helper! Our Father is sending a spirit of truth to help us. We have the helper living inside of us — the Holy Spirit. We can be just like that. We can actually take on the character of the Holy Spirit. What does the Holy Spirit act like? There's a list. Gal 5:22-23 — Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. This is it — a helper map. It starts with love, joy, peace. Can you imagine joy incarnate? Love incarnate in the kitchen? Imagine walking into the kitchen and there is joy incarnate cutting vegetables.

Or it could be just any "old" woman sweeping the hallway, thinking about having to get this done, so that next

she can do that and that and she'd better hurry up... just any "old" woman. Or she could be just any old woman in the throws of oppositional thinking. But, what if she were joyfully sweeping the hallway? Joy helps people. What if joy filled her life because the Helper was upon her? How hard it is to be filled with joy! But don't let the enemy deceive you.

Help is when you have love, joy, peace, patience, etc. This helps people. We are helping all the men like this. Being joyful, happy, peaceful, faithful to do that single brother's laundry, or cook this meal, or whatever.

If we could just band together and make a covenant to set ourselves to be a new Eve — Hadashah Havah, The new Eve. When we put these headcoverings on we are making a vow to our Father to be that, and not be weighed down by all the things that can hold up back. We can wake up in the morning and say, "Abba, I want to help." Give me your Helper so I can look like a helper and act like a helper and be a helper. The woman has the moon under her feet. Tomorrow morning you may not FEEL like asking for help, but that's what you have to overcome. She's overcoming and putting all those emotions under her feet — PMS and all that. Don't give yourself any room to eat the bread of idleness. We are supposed to have the moon under our feet. Our job is still our job (even with PMS); you can still be a help, you have to overcome.

Finally woman is being restored to be who she was created to be — a helper.

Our men are not embarrassed to be "the Bride" because they have vision to be that woman on the flag. Let's be who we were meant to be, not being weighed down by things like, "What am I going to wear today? What do I look like?" We are not going to get caught up in how we look. That is not our national identity. We are properly clothed women. We don't dress immodestly, or flashy, or to bring any attention to ourselves. We are not attracting men on that principle. We are teaching our women what a true woman is. We have vision to lay aside all the things that want to weigh us down and make us the old Eve. We've had enough of the old Eve. We are holy women, not like the rest of the world.

We need to be active, trying to find a way to make a cottage industry, helping with the needs. Be creative — don't let yourself be held down. Be positive. Let's be the helpers we were supposed to be. If you do that you will see amazing things happen to your husband, abba, leaders.

We are going to set ourselves to helping. Once you set yourself to that, then scheduling and lunch cleanup will look differently.

Let's be women who are setting their minds on doing what is right. Don't let yourself fall below the standard that is there for us. It's all in the book. It's really important that you let it into your heart.

Shua shel Boaz — I heard the secret, "Let's band together." We can make a conspiracy, a plot, and change the world!

Emunah shel Yadutan — After having grown up in the Community, learning to be busy working and getting a lot done, a worthless spirit can come to me at a time when I'm told I need to rest. But I see I can still be a help; it's not just what I can do physically that will make me a "helper."

Yerushah — I can be using my power to pull down instead of pushing up.

Baruchah — A large part is a matter of our willingness — are we surrendered? We can be hindered by our unwillingness. We have to be willing to put our hand to the plow.

Rachel shel Ohevi — I saw that the character of the Holy Spirit is what helps. We will become like Him as we do what we were created for... to help.

Shua shel Neriyah — Now we have a helper to be able to truly be a help.

John 13, 14, 15, 16 — Our Master gave everything so that we could have the Helper. Will we just go on without Him? We can see our Master's heart toward us in giving us the precious Helper.
