

All Who Believe Have an Abundant Life

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. (Jn 10:10)

Yahshua came to give all who believe an abundant life together — beyond the ordinary expectation of the daily life in the world. Acts 2:44 — All who believe have all things in common, because all who believe live together as a new family (Jer 31:1; Mk 3:31-35).

The adversary came for a different purpose. All who do *not* believe listen to him. But all who *do* believe listen to our Master Yahshua. All who believe listen to the Spirit of Truth because they are all of the truth (Jn 18:37). They serve our Master Yahshua night and day. Those who do not believe listen to the adversary night and day, for he is the accuser of the ones who believe.

Those who believe do not listen to the adversary's accusations, for he came to kill, steal, and destroy. But our Master Yahshua came to give all who believe a life beyond the ordinary life of those who listen to the voice of the accuser. All who believe *hear* the voice of the One who came to give them His life. They do not listen to the voice of the false shepherd, who opposes the voice of the Good Shepherd.

Eph 4:1-7 is our calling, our employment, our only occupation (Acts 26:7; Mal 1:11). All who believe are one. They maintain the bond of peace because they love one another. If it's obvious to the world, then how much more should it be to us? (Eph 4:1-3; Jn 13:34-35; Jn 17:21-23; 1 Jn 3:14,16,23).

Mt 6:31-33 tells of the extraordinary way of life and peace from the Father of Lights, who enlightens our way. All who believe are enlightened (1 Jn 1:7).
