

## A Constitutional Amendment

When they have to amend the Constitution to make it against the law to have same-sex marriages, then you know the foundations are being destroyed. It is becoming like Sodom and Gomorrah.

To *amend* the Constitution — do you know what *amend* means? It means to add to in order to strengthen; to put right. That is speaking of the Constitution of the United States. But man has a constitution: it's his conscience. *Constitution* means the composition or forming of something. At least we can warn people. You're driving down the street, school lets out, and you see hundreds of little children coming out, and they're all going to hell. They're being raised to go to hell. And it's just horrible.

But we're going to have a light here in the Vista area so that at least we can warn the people of Vista, and in every location we're in. They don't have to go to hell; they can understand that we have a place for them to come, and we can pray for them. And those who are willing to do our Father's will, will come. And there will be many people — hundreds, even thousands of people up and down the coast.

We'll even be near San Francisco, I guess. I don't know if they have children there or not, but whoever it is, they will have an opportunity to be saved. That's why we're here, to be the light, to be that seed in Rom 9:29 that produces the remnant in verse 27, or the whole world will become like Sodom and Gomorrah.

But we have all the sins of the world in us — all the sins of the world we have to put under our Master's feet, and when He comes back, He said we'll be standing with Him. We'll be standing with Him over all of His enemies that we've put under His feet. He can't come back any other way. We have to put all the world's sins — that we have — under Him. And then He'll come back and destroy evil on the Earth. The few that are left will be the scions in the next age, and repopulate the earth again.

The reason they say the Constitution has to be amended is because there's a loophole there, and if it's not closed up by this amendment then everything will be destroyed. Everything will start falling after that, if this hole is not closed up to prevent same-sex marriages. If they allow same-sex marriages, there's going to be a great breach. Do you know what the Constitution is? It is the makeup of America. It's the makeup of the man. That's our constitution, what we're made up of.

Joseph Fisher – I was thinking today how our prayer at the minchah is the most important aspect of our life, because this really determines what happens. This is where our hearts cry out to our Father, and our Father hears us, and is able to change things, cause things to happen, cause us to increase and the world to allow us to increase. And that's where our defense lies.

Shemiyah – When the foundations are destroyed what can the righteous do? What can they do but move into the Community? We need to pray that we would be that place for people.

As long as we can lift up holy hands without any division or dissension, our prayers aren't nullified as a Body. We give our bodies as a living sacrifice — one sacrifice. Otherwise there would be a breach, and it would be over. That's what came into the First Church and destroyed it.
