## When the Spanking Stopped A Bastard Nation

The nations have sunk in the pit that they made; in the net that they hid their own foot has been caught. (Psalm 9:15)

I don't know about you, but if I had a child, a *wanted* child, I would love that child. And if I *really* loved that child, the last place I'd want him or her to spend eternity would be the place where all children who are not whipped go when they die. But there is a promise to all who love their children enough to discipline them with a reed-like rod (Pr 23:13, Amp). All who hate their child will *not* discipline him or her, that is, will not *whip* him or her. This is substantiated<sup>1</sup> in the record of the Word of God, the Bible.

I do not want to be one who ignores God's Word, or is disobedient to it, which is to be disobedient to God, for then not only will the child not be saved from the place of torment, but neither will the father — me. So what shall I do? Obey God or obey man? Would it be better to obey God, or would it be better to obey man rather than God? Is it scriptural to obey God rather than man? To obey God rather than the authority of the United States of America? Who should I obey? (Acts 5:28-29)

Lk 6:46-49 — So what does God's Word say? Pr 23:13-14 says, "Withhold not discipline from the child, for if you strike [discipline] him with the (reed-like) rod, he will not die (it won't kill him). You shall whip him with the rod and deliver his soul from hell" (Sheol, Hades) — the place of torment where those who are dead go who disobey God and their own conscience.

So any parents who are in the least worthy of a second life themselves (Jn 5:28-29; Rev 20:12-15), or any disciple of Yahshua who is in the least worthy of the Kingdom (1 Cor 3:12-15; Dan 12:2-3), must go to every extent possible to save his child's soul

from this place where departed souls go when they die, and also his own soul, from the same place our Master went Himself (Acts 2:24,27,31).

Lk 16:23-31, especially verse 28 — Yahshua, the Word incarnate, spoke these words, calling this place (that a child can be saved from) a *place of torment* (Pr 23:14), as our Master Himself went to this same place to suffer the consequences of our sins (Acts 2:24).

So a child will go to that same place eternally if his parents don't love him enough to whip him for his disobedience, and to correct him, to raise him up in the way he should go (Pr 22:6; Eph 6:4; 2 Tim 3:15). Because foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child (Pr 22:15), how (not in hell) can one get this out of him while alive on Planet Earth?

So in Pr 23:14, this place is a place of *eternal torment*, as our Master said in Lk 6:24-25 is the place where all the rich go when they die, to this same place of torment (Lk 16:28), where they will weep and wail forever and ever. This is the place that any parent will do all he can do to deter his child from going, for if not he too shall go to the same place of torment for hating (not loving) his child so much. But he would say he is only going along with the authority of the governments of the nations today, who say you should love your child enough so as *not* to discipline him (Pr 13:24).

Today they call love hate and hate love. How much more perverted can the governments of this world get, pray, tell me? Have you ever read the Book of Hebrews in the New Testament scriptures — the *Authorized "King James" Version* of the King of England?

Heb 12:6-11 — Is your son a bastard? Are you? You are if you are exempt from discipline and correction, in which all of God's children share. Then you are bastards and not true sons at all.

Is your country making bastards out of you all? Is the government made up of a bunch of bastards? They all became bastards when the spanking stopped, and all hell is breaking loose on Earth. The Bible calls you a bastard, and do you know why you are one? Take a good look at these words of God, if you are not a bastard yourself (and even if you are, you can be saved, for such were some of us): Heb 12:8; Pr 3:11-12; Ps 94:12-13; Heb 12:5-6; Rev 3:19; Pr 19:18; 22:15; 23:13-14; 29:15,17.

So the governments today are made up of illegitimate politicians elected by the illegitimate populace. That's plain as day.
